



**Game Card Protocol
Recreation U9-U12
2025**

A Game Card is a document that the Center Referee uses during the game to record scoring, player or coach offenses, and final score that requires both coaches and center referee to sign off. Game Card is the documentation to report the final score, if there are any scoring discrepancies, player, coach or fan abuse and related game comments.

- The Home Team Coach is responsible for printing [game card](#)!**
- Download and print the document for the Game Card prior to the scheduled game.
- Game card can be found in the Playmetrics Platform.***
 - In the Playmetrics App, login to your **Coaches Role**, click the **Menu** button, click on Club Resources, and download the game card.
 - On Desktop, login to your Coaches Role, Click on Club Resources, then download the game Card
- Prior to game, provide Center Referee with Game Card. The Game Card must be filled out by the Home Team Coach with the Game Number, Age Group, Home and Away Teams, Field Name, Date/Time of the scheduled game.
- After the Game, the Center Referee will ask the Head Coaches to sign the game card. Both Coaches should take a picture of Game Card. The Home team Coach will hold onto the Game Card and be prepared to send to Club Admin if requested.
- The Home team will be responsible for entering the score within 24 hours via the Playmetrics app.

 - If the score hasn't been entered by the Home Team Coach within 24 hours, Visiting Team Coach may enter score.
- Game Notes -
 - Referee is not responsible for entering the game score in Playmetrics App
 - If there is a **score discrepancy**, Club Admin will request photo of game card from Home team Coach.
 - Club admin will review the game card, reach out to each coach and determine next steps leading up to finalizing the score. **Once Admin reviews and makes a decision, the decision will not be overturned.**
