Tea Park & Recreation Board Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, October 23, 2024 at 6:30 pm

The regular meeting of the Tea Park and Recreation Board was held on Wednesday, October 23, 2024 at 6:30pm at Tea City Hall. Board members present were: Vicki Pick, John Ganschow, Jeff Portner, & Curt Hauff. Chaired by Brian Headrick. Also present: Jake Kerr & Seth North (owner of Titan's Tavern)

- Motion made by Portner and Seconded by Hauff to approve the current agenda as printed. Ayes, all in favor. Motion carried.
- Motion made by Portner Seconded by Pick to approve September 18, 2024 Tea Park and Recreation Board Minutes. Ayes, all in favor. Motion Carried.

PUBLIC SPEAKING

- The board recommends allowing Tea Titans Tavern to have a Sand Volleyball League at the City of Tea Sand Volleyball Courts. Before Titans Tavern can start a league, they must get approval from Tea City Council and sign an agreement contract with the City of Tea.

RECREATION REPORT

- Headrick provided an update on Flag Football. Season was completed on September 28.
- Kerr provided an update on Fall Soccer. Season was completed on September 28.
- Kerr provided an update on Adult Co-Ed Volleyball League. Completed 7 weeks of game. Playoffs will be on October 30 and November 6.
- Kerr provided an update on Youth Basketball (KDG-1st Gr.). In 2024 we have 115 participants, and in 2023 we had 90 participants. Kerr was happy to see an increase in girl participation in the program so we can have separate girl and boys teams unlike last year.
- Kerr provided an update for Youth Indoor Soccer. Registration will open on Monday, Sept. 28.
- Portner updated the board on baseball uniforms. The baseball program needs new baseball jerseys for the 2025 season. Kerr provided potential uniform designs to the board.
- Kerr provided the Tea Parks and Recreation Participation number on the agenda. Kerr just wanted to note that the 3rd and older for soccer is no longer included in the participation number since starting in 2024 they now register directly with DASC. That information is also included in the document.
- The Tea Parks & Rec. Board wants the Tea City Council to look to see if there are options to better improve the grass area on the South Side of the Tea Athletic Complex. This is where 3rd grade and older teams practice in the Fall and Spring.

- Kerr reported he's still working with the school district with a partnership with the school district for getting a shuttle bus to Wild Water West.
