## ROLES and RESPONSIBILITIES

**Commissioners Meeting:** attend the Commissioners Meeting March 20th

**Communicate** with your team's Head Coach on rules and drafts when needed (minors, Majors and Intermediate) Make sure you get everyone's email and phone number.

**Communicate** Directly with the VP of Baseball or Softball on any issues that come up during the season from parents, and coaches.

**Field Closets (Please check before April):**

**TBall (Myrtle container)**

- 4 Buckets of #1 balls
- 4 rubbermaid boxes w/
  - 4 bases
  - Tape measurer
  - Ice packs
  - Field 1 box has the main First Aid kit
- 4 Functional Baseball Tees

**Farm/Minors (Barr closet & Orange Box)**

- 2 Buckets of #1 balls, & #5 Balls (Practice and games)
- 2 sets of catchers gear
  - (All buckles and helmets are functional)
- Chalk (At least 3 bags)
- Chalk Machine
- Batter Box Template
- Field Mat and Tractor (Key in Fishing Box)
- Ice Packs and First Aid Kit
- 3 Bases and 40' Temporary Mound

### **Majors (Johnson Field & Field Boxes )**

2 Buckets of #5 balls, & #AD100 Balls (Practice and games)  
2 sets of catchers gear  
(All buckles and helmets are functional)  
Chalk (At least 3 bags)  
Chalk Machine  
Batter Box Template  
Field Mat and Tractor (Key in tractor cup holder)  
3 Bases  
Ice Packs and First Aid Kit

### **Intermediate (Fater Field)**

1 Buckets of #AD100 Balls (Practice and games)  
2 sets of catchers gear  
(All buckles and helmets are functional)  
Chalk Machine  
Batter Box Template  
Tractor (Key in tractor cup holder)  
3 Bases  
Ice Packs and First Aid Kit

**Baseballs/Keys**—Each team's Head coach gets a #14 Key and 12 baseballs (except Minors, they get (2) 12 packs). These must be distributed to the coaches before the Meet the Coaches day  
Tball/Farm = 1's Minors = 1's & 5's Majors = AD 100's. Balls will be used for practices and games. If they need more they must let you know.

### **CALL UP LIST (Majors, Minors and Intermediate)**

- At the conclusion of the second week of League games, each Manager will notify the Player Agent and Commissioner of those players on his or her team who should be included on a Call Up List
- Players placed on the Call Up List will be eligible to play in games in the next age Division on an as-needed basis to ensure teams in the older Division have enough players for each game.
- No Player on the Call Up List may be called up more than once until all other Players on the Call Up List have been afforded an opportunity to play as a Call Up.
- This program will be in place for Rookie/Farm to Minors, Minors to Majors and Majors to Seniors /Intermediate Divisions.
- Players must be one age level lower to be called up. For example, in baseball 7 for Minors, 8 for Majors, and 10 for Intermediate. For Softball, the player must be one grade level lower/2nd year in division to be called up (ie 3rd Grade or 2nd year Minor Player to be called up to Majors)
- A player may not play in an older Division game which conflicts with a game scheduled for the player's primary MBS team.
