#### **PLAYER'S INSTRUCTIONS**

Officials of Northern California Babe Ruth Baseball and the hard working hosts in this community have made extensive efforts to make sure your stay will be pleasant and rewarding. Therefore, we will expect that you absolutely cooperate with the following regulations regarding your actions during the State Tournament.

<u>SPECIAL NOTE</u>: Host team players are subject to all requirements and activities.

#### 1. ASSISTANCE

We want all participants to thoroughly enjoy themselves during the State Tournament. If you need any information or assistance, contact your Team Manager immediately. He, in turn, may rely on the aid of Tournament Headquarters.

#### 2. CONDUCT

Your conduct must be above reproach on and off the field. Any misbehavior or misconduct not only could cause your disqualification from the State Tournament, but also could disqualify your team.

#### 3. SCHEDULE

Follow your team schedule at all times. Be at practice sessions, State Tournament games, and special events on time. Be sure to check with your Manager and Host Family (if you are staying with one) whenever you wish to change from the listed functions.

#### 4. APPEARANCE

As Champions of your District or Host Players, we expect your dress to be neat. You may, of course, dress informally and comfortably. Each player is expected to wear his team's <u>baseball cap</u> if you are attending the Tournament, but are not at your scheduled game. At all times, neatness and cleanliness or appearance is required.

#### 5. UNIFORM

Each Player, Coach and Manager on the same team shall wear a different number on their uniform. The official Babe Ruth Baseball shoulder emblem must be worn on each Team member's left shirt sleeve.

Player's shall wear their team baseball cap at all times.

#### 6. MISC.

- Do not request money, gifts, or special favors from your Hosts at any time. If you need special assistance or guidance, contact your Team Manager or a member of the State Tournament Staff.
- Members of the Host Team are to be treated and are subject to all the same regulations as the District Champions.
- Do not go barefoot in the ballpark.
- Check with your Manager and/or Coaches before ever planning on going swimming, particularly on games days.

#### From Sacramento:


- Take 80 West towards San Francisco

- Take 101 South to the Ralston Avenue exit (Exit 412)
- Turn left onto Ralston Ave. Take the 1st left onto Island Pkwy
- Take the second left into the parking lot for Belmont Sports Complex
- Take a right into the dirt parking lot adjacent to the North field.

#### From the Bay Area (North of Belmont)

- Take 101 South to the Ralston Avenue exit (Exit 412)
- Turn left onto Ralston Ave. Take the 1st left onto Island Pkwy
- Take the second left into the parking lot for Belmont Sports Complex
- Take a right into the dirt parking lot adjacent to the North field.

#### From the Bay Area (South of Belmont)

- Take 101 North to the Ralston Avenue/Marine Parkway exit (Exit 412)
- Exit from the center lane to go straight onto Island Pkwy
- Take the second left into the parking lot for Belmont Sports Complex just past the Autobahn Motors
- Take a right into the dirt parking lot adjacent to the North field.


