

Elgin Youth Football & Cheer (EYFC)

Covid-19 Policy

Any child or volunteer member suspected of having COVID-19 or diagnosed with COVID-19 shall be required to leave the field; however, child will be placed in an isolation location to minimize exposure to other children and volunteers. Isolated child must always be supervised and immediate phone call placed to the child's parent. (maybe by the shed or lower field bathroom)

Symptoms of COVID-19 are fever (temperature greater than 100.4F/37C), chills, sore throat, runny nose, cough, shortness of breath, muscle aches, headache, vomiting and diarrhea.

Diagnosed

If the child or volunteer member is diagnosed with COVID-19, he or she may not return to the field until ALL three of the following are met:

- a. Individual is free from fever without the use of fever-reducing medications for at least 72hours.
- b. Individual is no longer showing symptoms, including cough.
- c. Individual has quarantined for a minimum of 14 days.
- d. Doctor's statement allowing child or volunteer to return to the field.

Symptoms

If the child or volunteer has symptoms related to COVID-19 and subsequently it is determined by a medical provider it is not likely that the child or volunteer has a COVID-19 infection, the child or volunteer may return to childcare if the following criteria are met:

- a. No fever for 72 hours without the use of fever reducing medications (fever is temperature greater than 100.4F/37C)
- b. Negative test for COVID-19 (in writing)or;
- c. A note from a medical provider documenting no clinical suspicion of COVID-19infection

Teams

All children and volunteers on team that has been exposed to/with COVID-19, he or she may not return to the field until ALL three of the following are met:

- a. Individual is free from fever without the use of fever-reducing medications for at least 72hours.
- b. Individual is no longer showing symptoms, including cough.

c. Individual has quarantined for a minimum of 14 days.

d. Doctor's statement allowing child or volunteer to return to the field.

Close Contact

Any child or volunteer with close contact (within 6 feet for greater than 15 minutes) to a person suspected or diagnosed with COVID-19 shall be excluded from day care for 14 days and monitored for symptoms. If symptoms develop, they should be evaluated and tested for.

Temperature Taking

All children and volunteers will check their temperature before every practice, scrimmage, or game. If temperature greater than 100.4F/37C, child or volunteer will remove themselves from the field and follow up with their doctor for a medical release to come back to practice

Communication

In the event of a staff member or child in attendance testing positive for COVID19, all families and staff will be notified immediately via email.

EYFC will follow the guidance of the Kane County Health Department regarding next steps. Families and volunteers are expected to immediately notify EYFC if someone in their home tests positive or if the child has been in close contact (within 6 feet for greater than 15 minutes) with a positive case.

Sanitation Equipment

Football equipment will be sanitized after each use. Sanitation procedures utilizing a disinfection solution as defined by DCFS Section
