Notes:

- Steel forward **Matt Coronato** tallied a goal and three assists in the win, setting the United States Hockey League record with a 26-game point streak. Dating back to Feb. 14, 2020, Coronato has totaled 52 points (23G, 29A) over the life of the streak.
- The Steel set a season high with 11 goals and a seven-goal second period on their way to an 11-2 victory against Team USA (U17) on Saturday night at USA Hockey Arena ... Chicago went 1-for-1 (100%) on the power play and successfully killed off 2-of-3 (66.6%) penalties taken in the win ... Team USA won the shots on goal battle by a 38-37 margin ... In the seven-goal middle frame, the Steel tallied 20 shots on goal, their highest total in a single period this year.
- **Josh Doan** netted his first career hat trick in the USHL and added an assist. The Arizona State University-bound forward eclipsed his season total from a year ago in the win and now has 17 points (9G, 8A) this season.
- Steel captain **Erik Middendorf** totaled four points with two markers and two helpers. The Scottsdale, Ariz., native pushes his season total to 28 points (13G, 15A).
- **Dawson Pasternak** registered two goals in the win.
- **Adam Fantilli** reached a career-high with four points (1G, 3A) in the win. He now has nine points (3G, 6A) on the season.
- **Sean Farrell** extended his point streak to 13 games (7G, 17A) with a goal and three helpers in the win.
- Rookie **Jackson Blake** pushed his season total to 14 points (7G, 7A) with a goal and two assists.

- **Colton Huard** added two assists and now has 11 points (2G, 9A) in 17 games during the 2020-2021 campaign.
- **Jack Harvey** (2A), **Lukas Gustafsson** (1A), and **Quinn Finley** (1A) each recorded their first USHL points in the win.
- **Luca Fantilli** added a helper.
- Goaltender **Nick Haas** made a season-high 36 saves between the Steel pipes, improving his record to 7-1-0-0 this season.
