

MSA Umpire Injury Reporting

Purpose:

To ensure all umpire injuries are promptly reported and handled in accordance with USA Softball insurance procedures and MSA protocol.

1. Immediate Action – Seek medical attention and ensure your own health and safety

2. Contact RPS Bollinger

If you are injured while umpiring:

- **Call RPS Bollinger at 1-800-446-5311**
 - Report the injury and begin the insurance claim process.
 - Be prepared to provide:
 - Your name and contact information
 - Date, time, and location of the injury
 - Description of how the injury occurred
 - Any initial treatment received

2. Required Signatures & Documentation

- The injury claim form must be signed by the State UIC, Jim Pellegrini (jdpelle@aol.com)
 - Complete and submit all necessary paperwork promptly as directed by RPS Bollinger.

3. Notify MSA

As soon as possible, inform MSA of the following details:

- Date, time, and location of the incident

- Type and cause of injury
- What actions have been taken so far, including:
 - Contact with RPS Bollinger
 - Any medical treatment received
 - Status of paperwork and communication with Jim Pellegrini

- Prompt reporting is essential to ensure coverage through USA Softball.
- Failure to follow this process could delay or jeopardize your insurance claim.
- RSPBollinger is secondary insurance and you will need to go through your primary insurance first
