Tupper Lake Hockey Association Parents

You must register your child with USA Hockey, and separately with the Association. This can be done online and the fee is \$43.00 for children over 6. If your child is 6 or under you still must register them, but there should be no charge.

To register online:

- 1) Go to usahockey.com **or** click the link on the first page of our registration site.
- 2) Go to the “Membership” tab along the top select “Registration” on the left, then select “Register Online.”
- 3) Click on the “Register Now” button on the right

Fill in information and submit. You will be given a confirmation number and this number is necessary to begin your child’s Association online registration. If you have a printer please print the confirmation and keep for future record purposes. Now go to our team registration site and create an account if you do not already have one from last season. Once you have your account and log in, you will begin the registration process and will enter your child’s confirmation/registration number you received from USA Hockey. Follow the on screen instructions, complete all pages and submit your registration and, if applicable, pay your fee online, or you can choose the option to pay later and submit a check to the Association Treasurer prior to the start of the season.

Equipment is available for rental, for ages **8 and under only**, through the TLHA. Information on equipment hand-out dates will be posted in the Free Press when it becomes available. There is a \$50 **non-refundable fee** for rental of equipment. You are responsible for the equipment and must turn it in at the end of the season. Equipment rental does not include skates, stick or cup.

Parents will be notified of their child’s practice times as soon as they are established; the Civic Center schedule is also in the Free Press each week with practice times.

Game schedules will be handed out by your coach once games are scheduled. Look to your coaches for changes in scheduling, which can occasionally happen.

Coaches, schedulers and the TLHA Board will do their best to keep everyone updated and aware of games, practices, changes, etc. Remember, we are human and sometimes make mistakes. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact your coach or any Board member at any time. Also, when filling out your registration form, please make sure that you give us a phone number and email address, this makes it easier for your child’s coach to keep in touch with you!
