Coaches Code of Conduct



This year as a COACH I agree to...

- 1. Be reasonable when scheduling games and practices remembering that young athletes have other interests and obligations.
- 2. Teach my athletes to Honor the Game. I will teach and reinforce fair play, respect for the letter and spirit of the rules, respect for the officials and our opponents.
- 3. Ensure that all athletes are treated fairly when providing instruction, lending support and allocating playing time...regardless of their ability!
- 4. Not ridicule or yell at my athletes for making mistakes or for performing poorly. I will remember that children play to have fun and must be encouraged to have confidence in themselves. I will praise publicly and, when necessary, correct privately (i.e. away from the team and with a parent if felt necessary).
- 5. Ensure that equipment and facilities are safe. This includes ensuring that all athletes are wearing shin guards and have removed all jewelry.
- 6. Ensure a physician or physiotherapist's note is given to me before allowing a player to participate in practices/games after an extended injury (i.e. any injury lasting longer than 1 week).
- 7. Return to play following a concussion MUST be accompanied by a physician's note \underline{NO} EXCEPTIONS.
- 8. Obtain proper training and continue to upgrade my coaching education/skills on a regular basis.
- 9. Remain open to feedback from players, parents, the association and/or Club Technical Staff.
- 10. Resolve team/player conflict by...
 - a) Talking directly to the player(s) in question away from the rest of the team,
 - b) Talking directly with the player(s) and their parents in question **away** from the rest of the team if the initial behaviour has not changed, and/or
 - c) Setting up a Parent/Coach/Player Meeting with Club Technical Staff if steps "a" and "b" do not resolve the issue in question.
 - d) Should steps "b" or "c" be required, I will keep a detailed record of the issue, discussion and resolution through email that includes copying Club Technical Staff in the email discussion.
- 11. Actively work with the Club Technical Staff to ensure parents provide *mid-season* and *end of session* feedback regarding the RASC Program as requested.
- 12. Speak in a manner that positively promotes and supports the RASC program, the MHSA, the Board, MHSA Staff, AND members of the RASC Coaching Staff regardless of team.
- 13. Follow the **24 Hour Rule** when expressing concerns to any member of the coaching staff, parents on our team, MHSA, Board and MHSA staff. Furthermore, that I will attempt to get both sides of the story before coming to any conclusions associated with the coaching of this team.
- 14. Avoid making negative comments about any of the teammates or parents of teammates in front of players. I understand that this will help to avoid planting seeds in the player's head that may negatively influence their ability to be a good teammate.

I understand that by signing this document I agree to all the items above. Should I fail to abide by these
terms, I understand that I may be subject to discipline under the MHSA Bylaws.
