

Sustainable Association and Residency Policy

Highland Ball has developed a joint policy in cooperation with nearby associations to ensure our community baseball programs remain sustainable into the future. Starting at 8U (2nd grade) we ask that players/families decide which association they would like to play in (if they are eligible for both). We ask that families do not double roster in both programs.

Please note the associations now have an annual process where we will be comparing registrations to ensure this does not happen. We require that once the decision is made, families stay in that association for the duration of their youth baseball experience.

In the event a family wishes to switch associations, we ask that they do the following:

1. Notify to discuss the reasons for leaving the association
2. Send the 'incoming' association a message with the 'outgoing' association copied the intent to join with the 'incoming' association. *This closes the communication loop between associations.*

All associations recognize there are several reasons that may lead to a player needing to move associations and we agree to work with families to get their player in the right spot for them to be successful.
