

CYHA Game Protocol – Shove Park Ice Rink

Effective February 1, 2021

The CYHA Board of Directors and the Town of Camillus are happy to announce that there will be hockey games allowed at Shove Park this season. We have worked very hard to ensure that all requirements from the Onondaga County Health Department have been met in order to provide a healthy and safe environment for all of Players, Coaches, Spectators and Staff.

Below are general rules and guidelines for our games at Shove Park.

- ***CDC recommended face masks are mandatory for every person entering the building and must be worn at all times until they exit the facility. This includes players, coaches, referees, and spectators.***

CYHA Volunteers

- Squirt, PeeWee, Bantam and Midget teams will need 7 volunteers for each game.
- CYHA volunteers may enter the building 25 minutes before game time.
 - 4 volunteers needed to work the Sign-in tables.
 - 2 will work the Home table; 2 will work the Visitor table
 - At each table, 1 person will take temperatures while the other person checks in players, coaches and spectators.
 - CYHA Head Coach or Team Manager will be responsible for providing the correct Sign-in forms for volunteers at Check-in.
 - After the game begins, 3 volunteers may watch the game from the bleachers.
 - 1 volunteer will need to remain in the lobby until volunteers for the next game arrive. This volunteer may watch the game through the windows in the lobby area or on the LiveBarn feed on the TV.
 - 1 volunteer needed to run the clock/scoreboard.
 - 1 volunteer needed to fill out the scoresheet.
 - 1 volunteer needed to work the Home penalty box.
- Mite teams will need 4 volunteers for each game to work the Sign-in tables.
 - Same sign-in procedure as detailed above.

Visiting Team Volunteer

- Visiting teams will need to provide a volunteer to operate the Visitor penalty box during Squirt, PeeWee, Bantam or Midget games.
- Visiting team volunteer may enter the arena 10 minutes prior to game time.

CYHA Players & Coaches

- CYHA players and coaches may enter the building no sooner than 20 minutes before game time.
- All players must come fully dressed with the exception of skates, helmet and gloves. Goalies will be able to put on equipment in the arena.

- CYHA players and coaches will check-in at the Home table and proceed to locker room assignments written on the board. Teams will be split up into 2 locker rooms to allow for social distancing.
- No more than 4 coaches are allowed in the Home bench.
- After the game, players will remove skates, helmet and gloves and immediately exit the arena. Goalies may undress quickly before exiting.

Visiting Team Players & Coaches

- Visiting team players and coaches may enter the building no sooner than 20 minutes before game time.
- All players must come fully dressed with the exception of skates, helmet and gloves. Goalies will be able to put on equipment in the arena.
- Visiting players and coaches will check-in at the Visitor table and proceed to the lobby area that will be used to put on equipment.
- Players will walk into the rink and place their bags at designated rinkside chair locations before entering the ice surface.
- No more than 4 coaches are allowed in the Visitor bench.
- After the game, players will remove skates, helmet and gloves and immediately exit the arena. Goalies may undress quickly before exiting.

Spectators

- Spectators will enter through the double doors in the main entrance facing the parking lot.
- 2 Spectators per player will be allowed to enter the facility to watch games.
 - A coach who is a parent of one of the players does not count as a spectator.
- Spectators may enter the arena no sooner than 5 minutes prior to the scheduled game time.
- Spectators must follow proper social distancing guidelines and maintain a 6-ft distance from others not in their group at all times.
- Spectators will be required to check-in at the designated Home or Away tables when entering the arena.
 - Temperatures will be taken at check-in. Anyone with a temperature of 100 degrees or higher will not be allowed to enter the arena.
- After check-in, spectators must immediately proceed to the bleacher area and find a location to watch the game from a designated 'X' location on the bleachers. Spectators must remain on or next to the designated 'X' location during the game.
- Spectators may watch the game from the bleachers only. Watching the game from the lobby, rinkside glass, or any other area inside the rink is prohibited.
- Public restrooms are available for use and are located by the main entrance in the lobby.
- Once the game is over, spectators should immediately leave the bleacher area and promptly exit the building via the back hallway by the locker rooms.
