

Pony Pride Training Fall Policy

- Anybody - including players, parents, guardians, spectators - attending a Pony Pride Training event should complete an at home self-evaluation prior to attending the event. We recommend referencing the [self screening checklist provided by the Minnesota Department of Health](#). Should a player, parent, guardian, or spectator check ANY of the boxes, he/she should refrain from attending the event.

Should a Pony Pride Training Fall Program participant test positive for COVID-19:

- It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to communicate a positive test result to us. We can be contacted via email at info@ponypridetraining.com.
- Pony Pride Training is required to report any known cases to the Minnesota Department of Health. We will follow any and all guidelines recommended by MDE.
- Pony Pride Training will notify all program participants of any known cases, while respecting to the privacy of the positive player. A general notification will be sent to all program participants. A more detailed and specific message will be sent to players who may have come in close contact with the infected player.
- In the unlikely event MDE recommends the suspension/cancellation of any/all programs, Pony Pride Training will pro-rate and refund families based on the number of hours attended. *Pro-rated refunds will be issued less 20% to help offset ice costs we would still be responsible for. In the even more unlikely event that facilities were to close and program cancelation was the result of that, a full pro-rated refund will be issued.*
