

GWLL 2026 Post-Season Awards Selection Process

Please see the criteria for selecting the GWLL Post-Season Awards. Each team will have the opportunity, but not obligation, to nominate up to 6 players from their team for consideration for Post-Season All-Conference placement. There is no requirement to submit the full 6 nominations so please only submit those players that you feel warrant recognition for their efforts and play on the field. From this pool of players (approximately 60 players from Northern Division, 48 players from Eastern Division), a 1st and 2nd All-Division team will be selected. The 48 1st Team All-Division players from Northern Division and Eastern Division will then be eligible for placement on 2 All-State Teams. A meeting will take place following the State Championship where coaches can describe their eligible players. A vote will take place via survey in order to select 16 1st team All State players and 16 2nd team All State players. For a total of 32 All State players

USA Lacrosse Awards: GWLL is allotted 3 All-American Awards by USA Lacrosse. Only 1st Team All-State players are eligible for All-American recognition. We have also been allotted 3 Academic All-American awards; these players must be in their Junior or Senior year and have a 3.7 or above cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale. We will follow-up with additional information once All-State teams are selected. A coaches meeting prior to a vote will be scheduled in order for each coach to discuss their nominated players. A vote will take place following the meeting. Any ties will be handled via runoff vote.

Timeline: All-Conference nomination forms will go out May 3 and All-Conference teams will be selected via SurveyMonkey and/or a league meeting by Thursday, May 13. All-State Meeting and subsequent selection meeting will occur the week following the GWLL State Playoffs. All-American nominations will be due by the first week of June and a selection meeting and vote will take place no later than June 12th.
