Tournament Rules

Welcome to Lethbridge for July 11-13, a great weekend of Major AAA baseball for the 2025 tournament season!

Tournament standings, schedule, and pitch counts can be found using the following:



Here are the rules of play:

1. Each game will have a game pack at the Dave Elton Park Concession containing a scoresheet and pitch count sheet. The visiting team (1st base dugout) will be responsible for pitch counts. The home team (3rd base dugout) will be responsible for scoring the game on the sheet provided. * Umpires will be responsible for picking up the game packages and returning them to the concession.
 - a. If coaches have any objections to either the score sheet or pitch count sheets you are to contact one of the listed tournament organizers prior to the next time slot of game starts. Any objections past this point will not be changed. * there is not sign off necessary so if you are concerned please check over the sheets before leaving your game.
 - b. Tournament organizers will update each game score and pitch counts as promptly as possible on the tournament spreadsheet.
2. No new inning after 1hr 45mins except for the two games on Sunday where they will complete each game to its entirety.
3. No max runs allowed rule.
4. Mercy rules are: 15 run differential after 4 innings of play. 10 run differential after 5 innings of play.
5. No extra innings until the final two games of the weekend.
6. Game Balls will be provided by the tournament. Umpires will arrive at games with provided baseballs.
7. Pitch counts and innings in the catcher position are as per the LL rulebook.
8. With 2 outs a courtesy runner, the last player put out, can be provided for either or both the pitcher and/or catcher.
9. Lineup cards will indicate player names, numbers, position, and ineligible pitcher(s).
10. Tie breaker rules
 - a. Tiebreaker 1 - head-to-head record during pool play
 - b. Tiebreaker 2 - Runs-Allowed Ratio: total number of runs allowed in pool play divided by 6 innings per game

11. No verbal or physical abuse of an official, coach, player or fans will be tolerated. There are no warnings. Any individual can and will be asked to remove themselves from the tournament and area of where games are taking place.

We look forward to hosting all teams this weekend! Our concession will be open all weekend providing snacks and hot food with both cash and electronic payment options.
