

Gateway Recreation Centre Covid-19 Protocol as of August 7, 2021

With the COVID-19 Pandemic and current public health orders, what was once normal is no longer. As a result, a number of precautionary protocols and procedures are being implemented to provide safety to the participants and staff of Gateway Recreation Centre.

Please do not come to Gateway if you or anyone in your family:

- are feeling sick,
- has come into contact with someone who is confirmed to have COVID – 19,
- has been in contact with someone who has laboratory exposure while working directly with COVID – 19 specimens, and/or
- has difficulty breathing or shortness of breath when at rest or lying down.

Facility Protocol

All staff members and visitors (participants, officials, spectators, etc.) must use the Province of Manitoba Online Screening Tool <https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool> to pre-screen before coming to the facility.

User Groups coaches/ contact will be responsible to self-assess, assess and pre-screen all of their participants prior to entering the facility. They must keep a copy of all participants with name, phone numbers, e-mail address and proof of having been pre-screened for each of their ice times for a minimum of 21 days

That all staff, volunteers, user groups, patrons, spectators that enter Gateway Recreation Centre are strongly recommended to wear a mask at all time while being in the facility.

Spectator capacity is limited to 50% (75 per rink and 62 in the indoor soccer pitch) and required to be 2 metres/6 ft. apart. In order to limit capacity one parent/guardian per child will be allowed in the facility.

It is the responsibility of the user group to ensure spectators do not arrive early (30 minutes) and that arena/indoor soccer pitch capacity limits are adhered to. The user group must monitor capacity to ensure compliance with the facility restrictions. Failure to do so may result in future ice/ Indoor Soccer Pitch rental being suspended for a period of time to be determined by Gateway Recreation Centre.

User groups will be allowed in the facility 30 minutes before their ice/indoor soccer pitch times. They must exit the dressing rooms within 30 minutes after their ice/indoor soccer pitch times.

Dressing Rooms are set to accommodate 20 in the rinks and seven in the indoor soccer (2 metres/6 ft. apart).

Participants are recommended to use the provided hand sanitizer when they enter the facility.

There will be no team or individual warm up/training outside the field of play.

User groups and spectators are expected to maintain a 2 metres/6 feet apart distance therefore congregating in the facility is discouraged.

Spectators will require to exit the facility as soon as the ice/indoor pitch time is finished.
