There will be a brief coaches meeting at 7:35 AM. Teams scheduled to referee should conduct a coin toss at 7:45. This is a 12 team tournament with 3 pools of 4 teams on 3 courts. All teams are responsible for their scheduled officiating duties including first and second referees, the scorer's table duties (score sheets, score board, a libero tracker if needed) and 2 line judges.

All pool play will be two out of three sets; rally scoring to 25 points with a 27 point cap, third set to 15 must win by two. One libero may serve per set. Final placement in pool will be determined by matches won. In the case of ties: head to head for two way ties, three way tie we will go to total sets won then points scored.

**Volleyballs and carts will be provided for warm up. One less item for you to carry!**

Ref team is responsible to start the clock when the previous match is completed. Warm ups will be 10 minutes, 2 minutes shared court, 4 minutes serving team and 4 minutes for the receiving team. Six minutes (3-3) for remaining matches.
