# Who is WASA

Since 2010, WASA has offered a full platform of adaptive sports and recreational opportunities. Athletes compete in wheelchair basketball, tennis, lacrosse, bowling, softball, sled hockey, quad rugby, goalball, and bocce. WASA welcomes persons of all ages with physical disabilities and/or visual impairments including wounded Veterans, innate or acquired disability. Every person, regardless of their ability, can compete. Over 150 athletes of all ages from throughout southeastern Wisconsin compete annually. WASA athletes set individual fitness goals and develop independent skills and fundamentals outside of team practices. Families are required to help with team fundraising, securing and transporting equipment.

Nationally, 20% of Americans live with at least one disability. People with disabilities are becoming the world's fastest-growing minority. The State of Wisconsin does not provide funding for adaptive sports. WASA is uniquely positioned to reach this goal through individual contributions, grants, sponsorships, special events and membership fees. WASA sports extend beyond the benefits of physical fitness and health. The sport is the tool to increased confidence and independence, playing for a team, belonging to a community, and improved mental health.

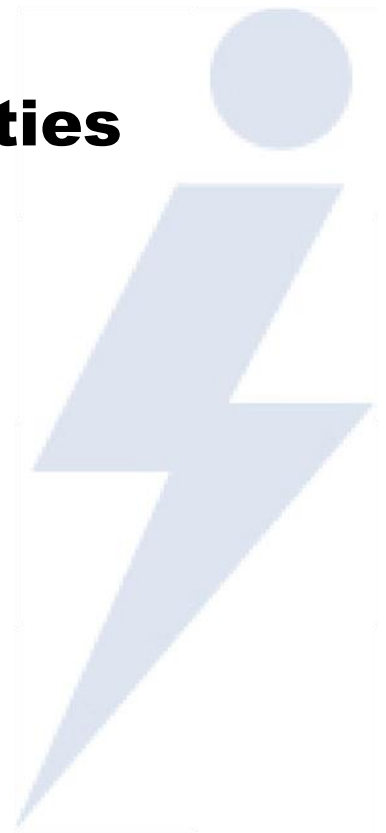
