



Responsibility for Reporting Misconduct

1. Referees shall transmit a written report of the alleged assault, abuse, or gross mistreatment, within 48 hours of the incident (unless there is a valid reason for later reporting) to the designee of the Member Organization that sanctioned the match and the State Referee Administrator. For tournaments or special events, the Referee shall transmit a written report to the tournament director on the day of the incident and to the referee's home state SRA, if applicable, within 72 hours of the incident.
2. Referees may be asked to submit additional information and should cooperate with the Organization Member having jurisdiction.

Responsibility to Attend Hearings *

1. Should a disciplinary hearing be held, referees are expected to attend and give testimony.
2. A referee who fails to attend a disciplinary hearing may be fined the equivalent of his/her game fee.

* This requirement does not apply for referees under the age of 18.
