In this week's Game Scenario you create the solutions as we continue to break down concepts for WE – PHASE 1>2. Please pick one of the offered GAME MOMENTS: Scenario 1, 2 or 3 and then create your play on the answer sheet pg. 12

Diagram Key:

Dashed Arrows = Player Movements

Direct Arrows = Pass or Ball Movements



SCENARIO - A

WE - PHASE 1: Building the Attack

What is the best option for the #5 in this specific situation?
Can you develop a plot for key player actions in 2 passes?







SCENARIO - B

WE - PHASE 2: Building the Attack

Consider the images presented, which color appears the best option? Why? Be prepared to explain your reasoning.

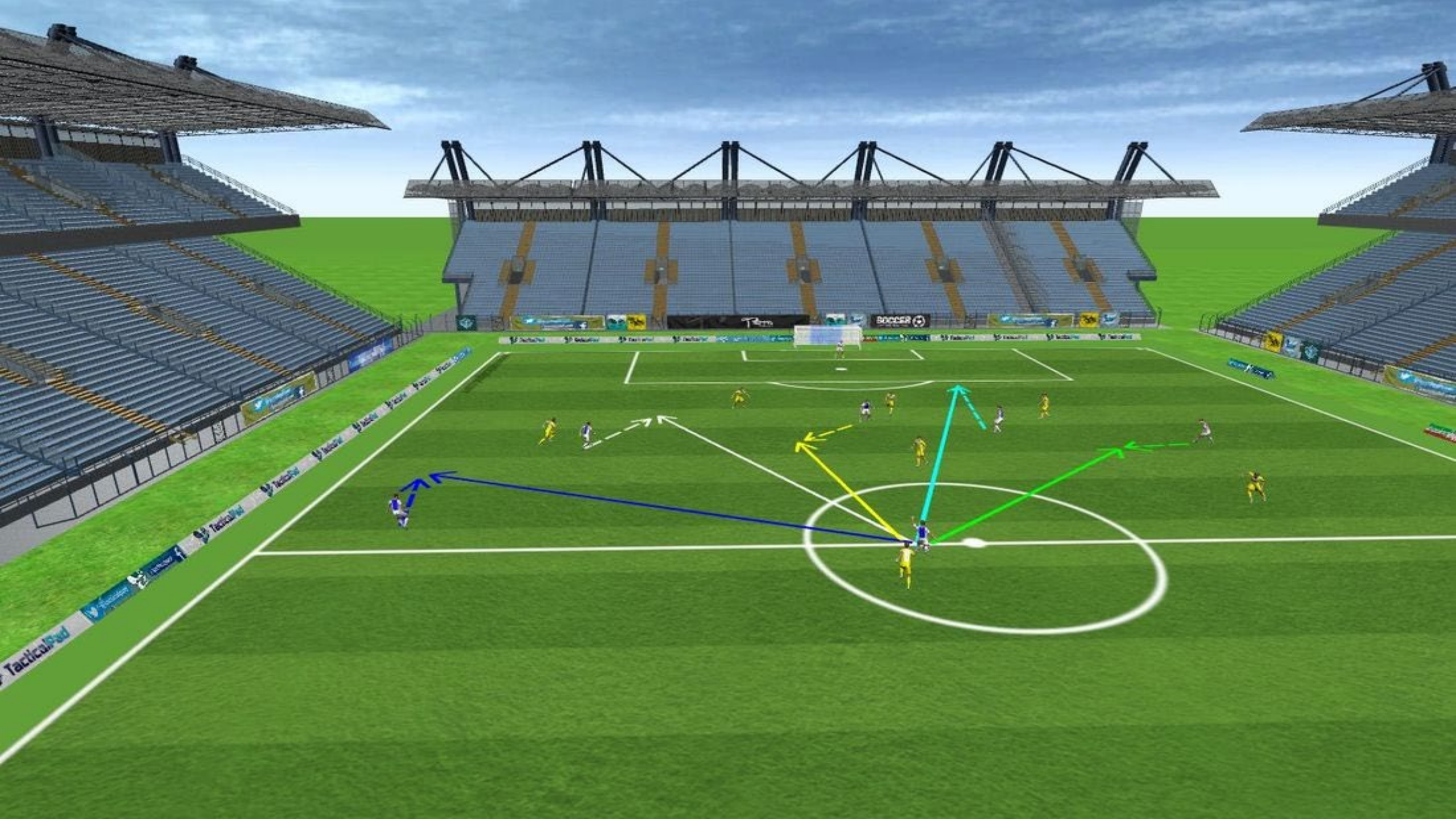
Blue - Play wide early into the supporting 3

White - Try and find 11 making the diagonal inside run

Yellow - Find the feet of the checking 9

Aqua - Seek to play 10 over the top and in-behind

Green - Find the 7 on the inside angle in space to receive at their feet









SCENARIO - C

WE - PHASE 2: Building the Attack

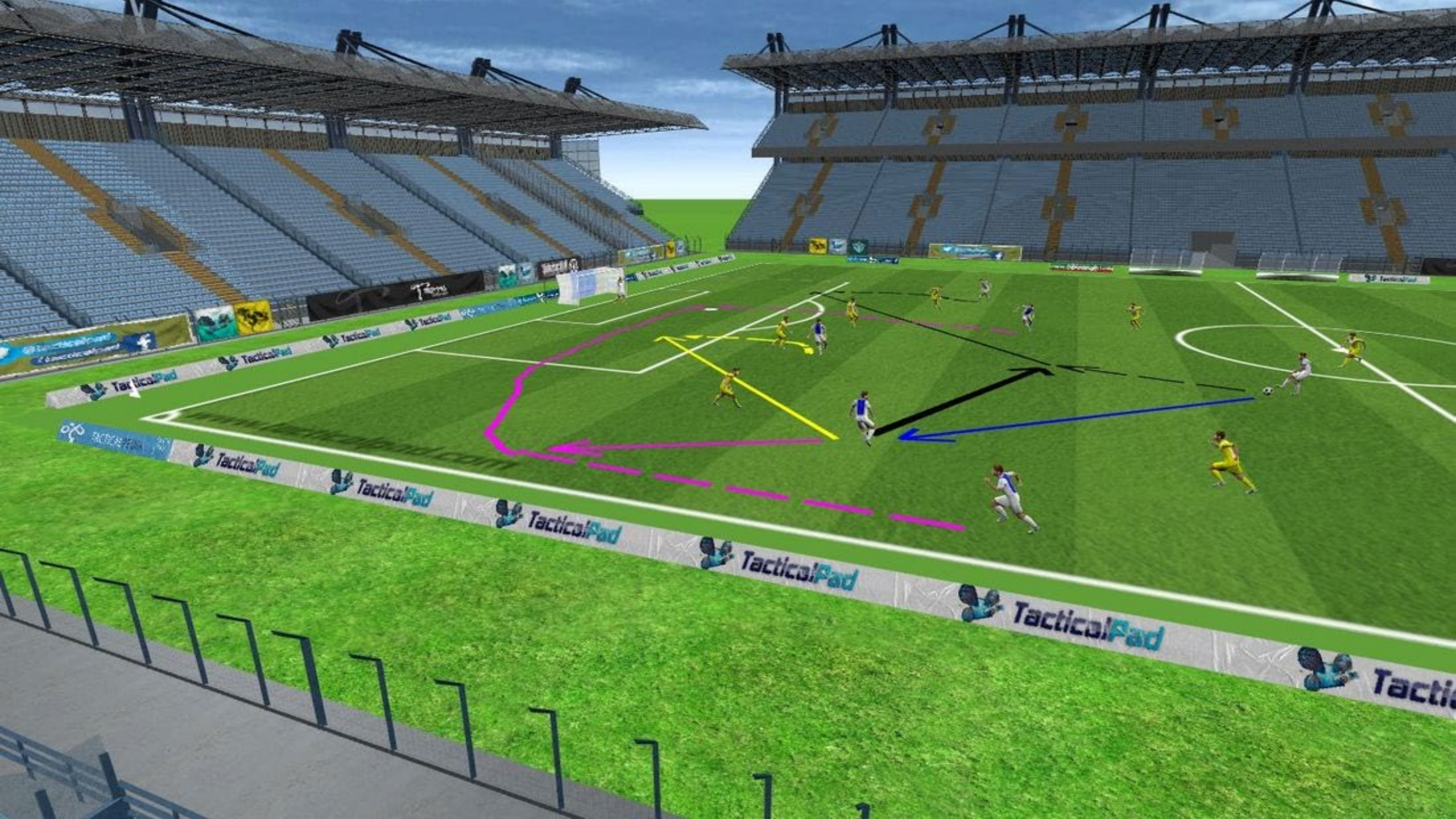
Consider the images presented, which colors appear the best option in build-up? Why?
Be prepared to explain your reasoning.

Blue-Black - A shorter pass into feet, laid back into an advancing run centrally

Blue-Pink - The shorter pass into 11, who then links with the overlapping 3 out wide

Blue-Yellow - Pass short to 11, then played in-between the lines for the 9 peeling off into the box
