



REGISTRATION FOR TEAM & INDIVIDUAL

REGISTRATION:	Team Rosters and Fees are Due by April 10 . Individual Registration Deadline and Fee is due by April 17.
ENTRY FEE:	\$275 per team, \$35 per individual
ELIGIBILITY:	<p>A <u>Varsity team</u> must be comprised of boys in 7th to 12th grade (Graduating classes of 2026 to 2031) who have participated in a minimum of three*, 9-hole high school matches during the current 2026 season prior to April 27. Team members must be presently homeschooling and eligible based on current 2025-2026 NCHAE Athletic Eligibility guidelines. Teams must have competed together as a team in a minimum of three, 9-hole high school matches prior to this championship to be considered a "team". *18-hole rounds count as two (2) 9-hole matches.</p> <p><u>Individuals</u> must be presently homeschooling and eligible based on current 2025-2026 NCHAE Athletic Eligibility guidelines. Individuals and those on a team must not have reached their 19th birthday before August 1. For an individual to qualify for the State Championship, that individual must have a 18-hole scoring average of 90 or less based on ~ 6,500 yards. That average is based on three scorecards attested and signed by an adult which are photographed or scanned and emailed to the Tournament Director (kyle.keller@basf.com) before April 24.</p>

PRACTICE ROUNDS:	<p>Players can call the Golf Shop at 910-692-6100 to reserve a practice round. They can book any time Monday - Thursday or in the afternoon on Friday - Sunday. Practice round is \$26 walking or \$54 with a cart (assuming you have a driver's license).</p>
COURSE SETUP:	<p>~ 6,500 yards, yardage subject to change</p>
FORMAT:	<p>The championship is conducted at 18-holes of team and individual stroke play with a maximum score of triple bogey on any hole.</p> <p>Each team may be represented by five players and must return four individual 18-hole scores to qualify for the team competition. In case of a tie for the team title, the fifth individual score will be used to break the tie. If the fifth individual scores are the same, ties are broken by comparing the total team score for top four players of the back nine holes, then last six, then last three, etc.. A tie for individual medalist will be determined based on the best score starting from the #1 handicap hole and proceeding through the course ranking.</p> <p>Team and Individual competitions are run concurrently.</p>
STARTING TIMES:	<p>Tee times will begin at 1:00 pm</p> <p>Pairings and tee times will be communicated to each coach and individual on Friday, May 1.</p>
PUSH / PULL CARTS:	<p>Push carts are allowed and encouraged for this event.</p>
RULES:	<p>USGA rules will prevail except where modified in the Local Rules sheet handed out at the start of play by Rules Officials.</p>
AWARDS:	<p>Medals: Awarded to the 1st place team. All-State Medals for top five individuals will also be awarded.</p>
PARENT & SPECTATOR POLICY:	<p>Spectator Information: Spectator carts are allowed at a rate of \$38 per cart. Spectator carts are restricted to the cart path <u>at all times</u>.</p> <p>Parent Policy: Parents are encouraged to follow their child(ren). We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path (roughs if no cart paths), unless assisting with the search for a golf ball. All spectators should stay a shot ahead (viewing from the landing zones) of their group so that they can assist with spotting tee shots as they land. Parents are not permitted to give advice, in any situation, at any time during play.</p>
