



## **NCHS EVALUATIONS, CHALLENGE MATCHES, LADDERS & NATIONALS ROSTER**

### **EVALUATIONS**

Will be held the week before Thanksgiving break.

Players will be evaluated and the challenge match process will begin.

Players will be laddered and assigned a team by the end of the week.

### **LATE EVALUATIONS FOR STUDENTS FINISHING A FALL SPORT**

Players who start squash after evaluations because of participation in a fall sport will have the opportunity to be evaluated by the coaches and laddered into the team as quickly as possible.

We will do our best to accommodate these players, however, due to court constraints, illness or limited practice time, it may take a while to get these players laddered.

### **CHALLENGE MATCHES**

Will be held approximately every week.

Matches will be the best of 5 games.

Challenge matches will be documented by the coaches.

If you are absent for any reason, you forfeit your match and move down one.

If you win, you will be moved up one position with the loser of the match being moved down one position. This could potentially move a player from one team to another.

### **LADDERS**

Ladders are based on wins and losses at challenge matches.

Ladders are not subjective.

Ladders are not based on seniority.

If you win, you move up. If you lose, you move down.

If you are absent for any reason, you forfeit your match and move down one.

Ladders are fluid depending on results of each challenge match.

### **NATIONALS**

The players who are going to play on the teams going to nationals (the Roster) will be named before winter break when we have to fill out entry paperwork or the week after winter break, depending on the Nationals schedule.

The LADDER for nationals roster will be fluid until the last challenge match before nationals.

Depending on the number of players in a given year, Boys Squash will take the top 7 or the top 14 players to Nationals (1 or 2 teams of 7). Players #15-18 will be the alternates and are required to be on hand for the weekend in case of injury or illness.

Depending on the number of players in a given year, Girls Squash will take the top 7 or the top 14 players to Nationals (1 or 2 teams of 7). Players #15-18 will be the alternates and are required to be on hand for the weekend in case of injury or illness.
