Program check ins:

Instructional update:

*112 registered and split between RMMS and HUES. There are 10 coaches, but concerns about gym space and volunteers for next year if numbers keep increasing.

*Next year there will be additional gym space at HUES.

Action Item

*Ashley will update the HBBC website to reflect current coaches.

Rec Update:

*154 player increase from the previous year.

*Suggestions of parents and players to have continuity of coaches if possible. .

*Due to absences and differing levels it makes it better for all if there are more than 10 players on each rec team.

*There have been some instances of assistant coaches and head coaches having interactions with referees.

Action Items:

*John will speak to Rec Coaches about communicating with players with appropriate tone and positive messages.

*John will collect more information about the incident with the referees as well as speak to coaches about knowing the rules.

*Jamie is going to talk to the 2 teams to get foul counts for complaints about refs at a specific location.

*Dave will contact the organization that HB was playing against to collect information and speak about proper conduct.

Travel update:

*MSBL asked us to host the end of season tourney. We are not interested.

*Stark will be stepping down as the travel director at the end of this season.

*Considerations for next year: Look at skills based versus grade based and consider allowing travel players who still need to build on their skillset to possibly play with some rec teams as well.

Recreational Jamboree:

*We will be hosting girls 5th and 6th at CSDA and boys 7th-9th at HBMS on 2/18/23

*Jamie will be the site coordinator for CSDA and John will be the site coordinator for HBMS

*Drafts of schedules to be to Dave L by January 31st.

Repairs:

*The hoop at RMMS has been repaired and the check has been mailed

End of season awards

*Placing an order for 90 gold and 90 silver medals to Crown Trophy for Instructional and Recreational teams.

Budget update:

*With registrations and generous donations we are at a balance of around 26,000. We still need to pay for awards and February's refs as well as possible tournament entries.

Proposal:
