- ▶ Make Sure I Have Nothing But Good To Say
  - ▶ “He Really Turned His Act Around” Is Still A Positive

# NCAA ELIGIBILITY CENTER

- ▶ [www.EligibilityCenter.org](http://www.EligibilityCenter.org)
  - ▶ Register Before June Of Junior Year
  - ▶ Coach Brewer Will Submit Transcripts After Junior Year
  - ▶ You Will Submit Test Scores For Verification – ACT Code 9999
  - ▶ Confirm Amateur Status
  
  - ▶ Required To Attend “Official Visits” Senior Year.
    - ▶ School Pays For Travel, Lodging, Meals
  
  - ▶ \$90 Fee (Coach Brewer Can Tell You If You Qualify For A Waiver)
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# ACADEMICS – CORE COURSES

- ▶ NCAA Eligibility Center Calculates GPA Using Only “Core Courses”
  - ▶ English, Math, Science, Social Studies, Additional (Language)
    - ▶ Not all classes are approved by the NCAA
      - ▶ Intro Algebra, Astronomy, Outdoor Education
      - ▶ World Religions is only “Core” approved religion class
  - ▶ Graduation From CDH Typically Satisfies “Core Course” Credit Requirement
  - ▶ Each Trimester = .34 Credits
  - ▶ No +/- Consideration (A=4 Points, B=3 Points, C=2 Points)

# ACT TEST REQUIREMENTS

- ▶ Sliding Scale – Not Always 18
- ▶ Super Scores
- ▶ Test Prep at CDH
  - ▶ Mr. McGuire & Ms. Norusis
  - ▶ 3 hour sessions for 4 weeks leading up to test - \$200
  - ▶ Single 3 hour refresher Thursday before test - \$50
    - ▶ **FINANCIAL HELP AVAILABLE!**
- ▶ Test Early To Identify Weaknesses (Feb Junior Year)
- ▶ ACT Pre-Test Taken As Sophomore Is Strong Predictor Of Initial ACT Score

    - ▶ Cannot Receive A Scholarship, Cannot Play, Cannot Practice for first year

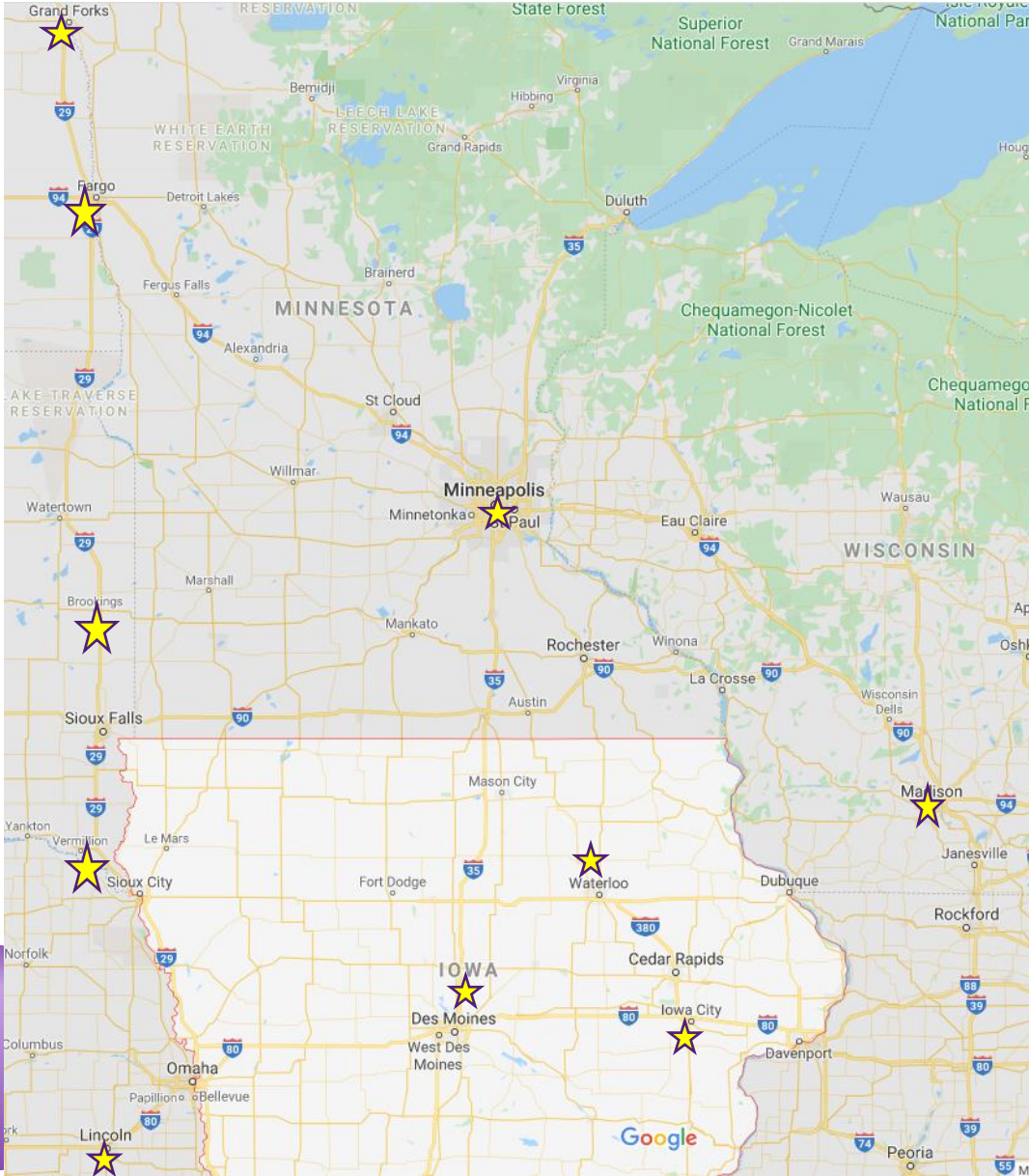
