- How much we paid non-coach volunteers for clinics
 - Do we have a name? No but VP found:
 - from the September 2018 meeting minutes:
 - The board reviewed the coach payout schedule:
 - Non-parent coaches get paid \$500 / season.
 - Level 1 certification adds \$250
 - Level 2 certification adds \$500
 - Level 3 certification adds \$1000
 - Certification bonuses do not stack.
 - Jim for evaluators who should we pay (donate)
 - Jim got field rental invoice for \$825
