

# EVANSVILLE SOCCER CLUB REGISTRATION POLICY

(Approved 7/15/24)

Parents of all new and returning players must register online. Payment is due according to the set payment guidelines at time of registration. All registered players are placed on a team for the next season (Fall and Spring).

Uniform orders for our MAYSA League teams occur after registration is closed, please expect an email and a tight turnaround time. Players need a blue jersey, a white jersey, and black shorts. Black socks and cleats can and should be purchased separately as needed.

## IN-HOUSE (Ages U4, U5/U6, U7, U8)

Opening and closing of registration, both spring and fall dates, are to be determined by the Youth Director, with guidance from the Director of Coaching.

Once registration is closed, all late inquiries shall be directed to the Youth Director and the President. The Youth Director and Director of Coaching will determine if there is room available on a team and place new players. The Youth Director will communicate directly with the families and Registrar and will assign late registrants to the appropriate team.

In all cases jerseys can be ordered, or the club can purchase a few additional jerseys/t-shirts to have on hand and charge new players accordingly.

## MAYSA Travel Teams (U9-U19)

Opening and closing dates for annual enrollment will be set by the MAYSA Advisor, in collaboration with the Registrar, taking into consideration the following:

- Final MAYSA deadline for creating teams for the appropriate league.
- Input from the team formation committee, with advice from the Director of Coaching.
- As well as the timeline for sending finalized teams to MAYSA.

The enrollment date will be communicated to the club members, and to the general public, by the Communications Director.

After Teams have been formed for the Fall Season and filed with MAYSA, any new enrollment will be determined based on the **Spring and Mid-Season Registration guidelines** (see below).

All other inquiries will be directed to the MAYSA Advisor, and copy in the Vice-President. The MAYSA Advisor will communicate directly with the families and the appropriate coaches.

If there are players that inquire about registration with a MAYSA Team with unavailable space, the MAYSA Advisor will manage a list of potential players. The MAYSA Advisor will communicate directly with player families if space opens on a team, or when the new enrollment period is approaching for the following season.

Jerseys will need to be ordered by the family.

## **SPRING MID-SEASON REGISTRATION**

New players will pay the full season fees, as well as purchase their uniform.

All spring/mid-season registrations will be assessed on a first come, first serve basis.

### **In-house teams, U4-U8**

All emails and inquiries after registration has closed, shall be directed to the Youth Director [esc.wi.youth.dir@gmail.com](mailto:esc.wi.youth.dir@gmail.com) , as well as the President, [esc.wi.president@gmail.com](mailto:esc.wi.president@gmail.com)

The Youth Director will check for roster availability to determine team placement, and communicate directly with the coaches of the potential teams and the player's family. The Youth Director will also communicate with the registrar.

Spring mid-season MAYSA registrations may be accepted at the discretion of the MAYSA Advisor and team formation committee

One criteria used to help determine placement will be the MAYSA Max roster sizes, which are as follows:

**U9/10:** 14

**U11/12:** 16

**U13/14:** 18

**U15-19:** 22 (18 allowed to suit up per game, more roster spaces are available due to higher player demands)
