High Jump: Two Pits (Boys - West Side and Girls East Side). Starting heights will be determined after seeding is released. Two increments down from the 8th place person. The bar must be raised two inches each time until six competitors remain. The bar thereafter will be raised one inch each time.

Pole Vault: Boys will vault first. Starting heights will be determined after seeding is released. Two increments down from the 8th place person. Bar must be raised six inches each time until six competitors remain. The bar thereafter will be raised three inches each time.

Shot Put: Girls Throw First. Three throws (3). Top 8 will advance to the final where three additional throws will be given. 1-1-1 format. 15 minutes of warm-up between trials and finals.

Discus: Boys Throw First. Three throws (3). Top 8 will advance to the final where three additional throws will be given. 1-1-1 format. 15 minutes of warm-up between trials and finals.

Long Jump: Girls Jump First. Prelims will run open pit format for 60 minutes. Three jumps (3) in the trials. Finals will be conducted in a reverse order format. 3 additional jumps will be given to all finals participants.

Triple Jump: Boys Jump First. Prelims will run open pit format for 60 minutes. Three jumps (3) in the trials. Finals will be conducted in a reverse order format. 3 additional jumps will be given to all finals participants.
