



SSYHA / Howelsen Ice Arena COVID 19 regulations

10.15.20

1) SPECTATORS:

- Howelsen Ice Arena will allow visiting teams a maximum of 2 spectators per player during games.
- Coaches on the player bench do not count as spectators.
- Members of the public will, through signage, be asked to enter the facility only if they meet self screening criteria.
- Tournament teams and spectators will be asked to submit a self screening acknowledgement before the event.
- Spectators will enter through main entrance no earlier than 15 minutes prior to the game and must check in and have a thermal temperature scan. Anyone who registers a high temperature and/or appears to be sick, will be denied further access to the facility.
- All spectators will be asked to sign in at the check in desk
- Masks must be worn at all times inside the rink.
- Per the Routt County Health Department- Anyone over the age of 10 must wear a mask at all times
- Spectators must view from the stands, the lobby and hallways are not open for spectators.
- Spectators must remain socially distanced in the stands.
- Spectators must exit through the side doors promptly after the game ends.

2). TEAMS AND COACHES

- Tournament teams and spectators will be asked to submit a self screening acknowledgement before the event.
- Teams may warm up outside the rink. There is no designated warm up area inside the rink.
- Teams and coaches may enter the rink 30 minutes prior to game time and will enter through front entrance.

- All teams and coaches will receive a thermal temperature scan at the front entrance. Anyone who registers a high temperature and/or appears to be sick, will be denied further access to the facility.
- Teams will go to their designated locker room and remain there until game time to avoid other teams from the previous game exiting the ice.
- Players will not stand in the hallways and may proceed from their locker room to the rink doors only at game time.
- Teams are responsible for wiping down their own locker room benches and shared surfaces before leaving. Disinfecting wipes will be provided.
- Players **must** have their own water bottle clearly identified with their name on it. Drinking fountains are not available.
- Absolutely no spitting while inside the rink, player benches or locker rooms.
- There will be no handshake line following the game. Players will line up on their blue line to acknowledge the other team.
- Teams will exit the facility through the side doors located in the middle of the arena within 20 minutes after the game ends.

3.) VOLUNTEERS

- Away teams will provide **one** adult penalty box volunteer.
- Teams may have one volunteer to video
- Clock operator, scorekeeper, penalty box and video volunteers will be required to wear masks the entire time.
- Volunteers will enter the rink from the front entrance and will receive a thermal temperature scan at the front entrance. Anyone who registers a high temperature and/or appears to be sick, will be denied further access to the facility.
- Volunteers will exit the score booth through the side door promptly following the game.

4.) Anyone unwilling to follow these regulations will immediately lose viewing privileges at Howelsen Ice Arena.
