

25-26 Mite/U8 goalie policy

MITE A / U8 A Goalies:

- Players interested in playing goalie **can register as goalies**, but also **need to make the team as skaters**.
- All players on the team will participate in a **full-team goalie rotation**. This rotation must take place during a **full practice, game, or scrimmage**.
- Once the full rotation is completed, the **registered goalies** may assume the goaltending position full-time and continue with focused goalie development.

MITE B / U8 B Goalies:

- All players must **register as skaters**. If your player would like to explore the position further after the team rotation is completed. Notify your coach and the goalie director.
- Each team will complete a **full-team goalie rotation** before any player becomes a designated goaltender.
- After the rotation, players with the **strong interest in goaltending** may assume the position going forward.

MITE C Goalies:

- MITE C teams must maintain an **equal goalie rotation among all players** throughout the season. No full-time goalies will be designated at this level.

MITE D Goalies:

- There will be **no goalies at the MITE D level**.

For MITE A/B, U8 A/B Teams:

- A **goalie rotation plan must be scheduled at the beginning of the season and submitted to the Goalie Director and MITE Director** by the **head coach or assigned goalie coach**.
