Elizabeth Seton Volleyball Championships 2025 Spectator Guide

Website

Full tournament information, locations, addresses, online ticketing, etc. are all available on The Seton website at: www.theseton.net

Tickets

The Seton is using Just A Game for online ticket sales to speed up the entry and make it easier to pre-purchase your tickets. The Admission cost is (same as paying at the door—no additional online fees will be charged):

Adults (High School & older) - \$6/person

Students (K-8 only) and Seniors (60+) - \$4/person

Kids 5 & under are free

Tickets are available for purchase by clicking on the ONLINE TICKETING link on the left-hand side of the Seton homepage. We will be able to accept cash, credit cards, Apple Pay, etc. at the door. If purchasing online, bring your QR code to scan for entry each day. **Please be sure you pick the correct tournament date, as tickets are only good for the day you select and are not refundable!** Tickets may only be redeemed once and will become inactive once redeemed. The Final Four tickets are good for entry at the Boys, Girls Division 2, or Girls Division 1 matches. You may only enter with a ticket once (must get a hand stamp when you enter to gain re-entry without purchasing another ticket).

Admissions will open approximately 30-40 minutes prior to the first match. No spectators are allowed in the court area until admissions is open to allow us to finish set-up each day.

Tournament Programs & Athlete Participant Bag Tags

The official tournament programs with rosters, team photos, brackets, and more will be on sale at the admissions tables while supplies last. We also have a limited number of Athlete Participant bag tags with the Seton logo for sale at the admissions table. Programs and Bag Tags are \$5 each (if paying cash) and \$6 if paying with a credit card.

Brackets

Pools/Brackets can be found online on The Seton website at: www.theseton.net Click on the appropriate division on the left. Once the tournament begins they will be updated by the end of each evening on the RESULTS page (tab on the left of the homepage).

Live Stream

The Milwaukee Sting provides free public wi-fi, so families can stream from their phones. There is no wi-fi or streaming available at Catholic Memorial High School.

Athlete T-shirt exchange/purchase

Each athlete will receive a complimentary T-shirt for competing in the tournament. If an athlete needs to exchange for a different size there are a limited number available at the admissions table (they must return one to get one). Extra T-shirts are available for purchase at the admissions table (\$10 cash or credit).

The Seton/Milwaukee Sting Center Spectator Rules

We appreciate having everyone present at the tournament to support all of the student-athletes. Please help us make this a **positive** experience for the players, coaches, and all those involved by abiding by the following rules to enter the tournament:

- **Parents must supervise their children.** *Children should not be running in the hallways, on the balcony, or remaining in the concession area or Julia Weber gym (CMH) without parent supervision*
- No ballhandling of any kind is allowed in the Milwaukee Sting Center outside of the courts during warm-ups. Balls may not be used in the hallways, in the balcony, behind the bleachers, or on courts A & B (between courts 2 & 3 or 6 & 7)
- No artificial noisemakers are allowed (no cowbells, air horns, slap sticks, etc.)
- Teams and spectators must vacate their court when on a bye in pool play to allow the seating/standing area to be used by the spectators of the teams currently playing
- No bag/folding chairs are allowed at the Milwaukee Sting Center. Stadium seats that go on top of the bleachers are allowed
- Please do not lean on the plastic fencing dividing courts at the Milwaukee Sting Center
- **Archdiocese of Milwaukee Sportsmanship Pledge** (spectators, coaches, and players agree to this by entering the tournament or facility)
 - As student-athletes, coaches, and spectators at this Archdiocese of Milwaukee event, we pledge to:
 - Display Christian behavior.
 - Show respect for student-athletes, coaches, officials, and spectators.
 - Refrain from profanity, racial and ethnic comments, harassment or taunting of student-athletes, coaches, officials, and spectators.
 - Encourage good sportsmanship by student-athletes, coaches, and spectators.
 - Take responsibility for our actions.
- All cheering should be **positive & supportive of your team** (team cheers should be celebrating with their teams, not directed towards an opponent). Negative comments or calling out opponents (saying things like “miss it”) will not be allowed
- Spectators may not enter the playing area (rubber surface behind courts), court, or team benches under any circumstance (other than to hand a player a water bottle), including after matches conclude
- Please do not cut across or block the corners of courts—there are walkways around the playing areas
- Spectators may not stand behind their opponent’s bench area
- Spectators may not yell at or give negative comments towards line judges, officials, coaches, or players. Doing so is grounds for immediate ejection from the tournament without refund. Multiple issues may result in a team forfeiting from the tournament entirely
- Pom poms, fatheads, and appropriate signs are allowed provided they do not leave debris on the court or delay the matches. Teams/spectators must remove all items after each match and may be charged if there is excessive clean-up needed on their court.

- No items may be hung or waved over the balcony at the Milwaukee Sting Center, including posters, pom poms, flags, etc.
- Schools/teams are responsible for fan behavior and may be charged for damage to any facility. Multiple spectator issues or disruptions may result in a team forfeiting their match

Concessions

The Milwaukee Sting Center does have full concessions available from 5-8 pm each weeknight of the tournament. Credit cards and cash are accepted. Please be generous to the workers—they are teenagers working virtually non-stop for 3 hours to serve you and appreciate any tips that go to the workers themselves!

During the Final Four at Catholic Memorial, their Booster Club will run a full concession stand during the matches. Cash or Credit is accepted at CMH concessions.

The Milwaukee Sting Center does have Wi-Fi available. Please look for the signs in the facility with the login & password.
