

ACBC May 16, 2016 Board Meeting

Meeting time 5:30-6PM: Discussion of partnership with Kingdom Hoops
6-7PM Regular Board Meeting

Partnership with Kingdom Hoops by Kirk Ridout, Bob Fontana, Scott DeJong. ACBC was approached by Todd Miller/Kingdom Hoops to create a partnership for the upcoming season (and potentially longer)

Details of Partnership:

1. Tuesday evening reserved for team practices. Teams will get 1 ½ hours of shared court practice each week/2 teams on 1 court. Teams will have consistent practice times that could begin as early as 4PM with priority of having practices of younger teams early & not having 9-10 practice times.
2. Wednesday evenings reserved for skills led by Kingdom Hoops staff and our skills director.
3. ACBC will have access to the Gym Rats League and all tournaments. (approx 35-40 games)
4. ACBC members will have access to the Kingdom Hoops Fall Skills during September and October, which is offered 4 nights/week.
5. This partnership will allow 9th-12th grade ACHS players access to Falls Skills for duration of this contract.
6. ACBC would pay Kingdom Hoops \$5000 per team for these services.

This partnership is under negotiation based on the following:

- A. Price negotiation: ACBC hopes to keep registration at \$650 with \$25 try-out free or \$700 with no try-out fee
- B. Option for ACBC teams to play in higher grade level if necessary.
- C. Option for ACBC to pay monthly installments to Kingdom Hoops
- D. Consideration of Wednesday “church night”, setting up optional Friday make-up sessions
- E. Discussion on the number & quality of tournaments (Kingdom Hoops hosts 6 tournaments a year) and whether or not these tournaments are beneficial & adequate for our teams.

Passed: ACBC fee would increase to \$650 with a non-refundable try-out fee of \$25 or \$700 with no try-out fee should the above partnership approve.

Boys Proposal for Limiting Teams by Bob Fontana

Due to limited gym space & to be more competitive, the Boys Program will limit the number of players & teams in the upcoming season as follows:

3rd-5th Grade: 3 teams each grade/10 kids per team/9 teams/90 kids/30 ea. Gr.

6th Grade: 2-3 teams /8-10 kids per team/2-3 teams/20-27 kids

7-8th Grade: 2 teams each grade/9 kids per team/3 teams/36 players/18 ea. gr.

Total Teams: 15-16 teams

Total Players: 146-153

(last year we had 175 boys & 20 teams)

Financial Report by Mark Den Adel

Mark shared several projected scenarios based on # of registered players, try-out fee potential, adding additional tournaments outside of Kingdom Hoops sponsored ones & actual amount we negotiation with this partnership.
