



## CBA COVID-19 Guidelines

1. All CBA Players, coaches, officials and scorekeepers **MUST wear face coverings** when entering any building in which CBA activities are to take place.
2. All persons, including players, coaches, and scorekeepers must use hand sanitizer provided and spaced through the game/practice and waiting areas before entering the gym. Players, coaches, and scorekeepers are encouraged to use hand sanitizer throughout the game/practice.
3. Players, coaches and officials only may remove their face coverings when playing/practicing. During games, when players are “on the bench,” face coverings must be put back on. Officials are strongly encouraged to keep their face coverings on their face even during the games.
4. Players may not share their water bottle as each player is required to have their own individual water bottle.
5. There will be NO SPECTATORS allowed in the gym for practice or games to comply with limits on the number of people gathering in one space.
6. CBA Players may enter the building in which a CBA event is taking place no more than 15 minutes prior to the start of the game or practice.
7. If weather is inclement to the extent that it is not safe to remain outside, players and coaches may wait in the hallway outside a gym. Social Distancing must be observed.
8. No player nor coach may enter the gym until all players and coaches have exited the gym from the previous game/practice.
9. The only ball allowed on a game court will be a CBA game ball provided to each set of teams. For practices and warm-ups, players are strongly encouraged to bring their own ball OR coaches may provide additional balls to players assuming they have been wiped and sterilized between each use.
10. Officials must clean the basketball used in any game before each game, between periods, at the end of each game, and whenever it is possible to clean during a pause in the game, such as timeouts.
11. Officials/players must clean chairs for their respective team prior to the start of the game and again at the end of the game. Spray bottles with cleaner and paper towels will be provided. Officials/teams are also asked to ensure the scoreboard is cleaned prior to and again at the end of each game.
