**COACH-PITCH (RULE 13) EACH TEAM WILL BE ALLOWED NO MORE THAN FIVE (5) ADULTS TO COACH THE TEAM AND MANAGE THE DUGOUT. NO MORE THAN THREE (3) ADULTS IN THE OUTFIELD WHILE ON DEFENSE!! TEAM MOMS THAT ARE ON THE FIELD OR IN THE DUGOUT ARE CONSIDERED A COACH!**

**KID-PITCH (RULE 11) EACH TEAM WILL BE ALLOWED NO MORE THAN A FOUR (4) ADULTS TO COACH THE TEAM AND MANAGE THE DUGOUT!!**

**ALL COACHES, ASSISTANT COACHES (DUGOUT/ON FIELD TEAM MOMS) ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE A BACKGROUND CHECK, NAYS CERTIFICATION AND CONCUSSION CERTIFICATION!** All three (3) are a must for ALL “COACHES”! Any coach that does not fill out a background check will not coach or be allowed on the field and/or dugout in Smyrna Baseball league. A link to the background check, NAYS certification, and Concussion certification can be found at [www.smyrnabaseballleague.org](http://www.smyrnabaseballleague.org). Once completed, each individual will be uploaded to our spreadsheet. NOTE: Anyone that will be on the field **or in the dugout must** be NAYS and concussion certified. *We will be checking the spreadsheets and you will not be allowed to get on the field until completed.* NOTE: You may want to keep a copy of your NAYS certification on you if your name hasn't been updated to the list in time for your game.

**TEAM MOMS WHO WILL NOT BE ON THE FIELD OR IN THE DUGOUT ARE NOT REQUIRED TO FILL OUT BACKGROUND CHECKS.**

- **Incident/Accident Report Forms**

If any type of incident/accident should arise on the field or during practice, an accident report must be filled out. Please contact the board member on duty immediately if an injury occurs at one of the parks or your age division's commissioners (within 12 hours) should the injury occur at practice. PLEASE NOTE: SBL's insurance is a rider, meaning our insurance covers what the injured individual's insurance does not. If incident is not reported within the 12-hour period, the league will not be obligated to cover any secondary expense.

- **Rain-Outs**

All rain-out information will be listed by 4:30 p.m. on our website [www.smyrnabaseballleague.org](http://www.smyrnabaseballleague.org). Your league's commissioner will contact your coach for the make-up game times. Please be sure to notify your parents of the make-up times well in advance. Please check the calendar to verify your game time. Our Lightning Policy/ Procedure is posted online for you to go over with your team's parents.

- **Zero Tolerance Policy**

Please remember that Smyrna Baseball League has **a zero tolerance policy for unsportsmanlike conduct, bullying, and cursing**. The players are here to enjoy and learn the game of baseball. Any coach, assistant coach, player or parent who does not adhere to the “no tolerance” policy, will be asked to leave the park immediately!!!! **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!** Please make sure your parents understand this! **If a coach or player is removed from a game, they are required to sit out for the next game as well. If a coach is ejected from a game at the Rec. Park and also coaches a team at Todd Lane, he will also not be allowed to coach his game at Todd Lane and vice versa. A second ejection in the same season can lead to a season long ban from SBL games and parks. Coaches, parents and players that have been ejected must be on the outside fence and take no part in the game!** A player, coach, or spectator that has been ejected from a game reserves the right to submit an appeal of their ejection in writing; however, SBL Board of Directors reserves the right to make all final decisions in cases of appeals. **Any issues related to an ejection should be addressed to your commissioner.** If there are **complaints with umpires**, these need to be addressed only by the head coach and only with the Umpire Liaison, Steve Carter.

- **Sponsors**

- **Scorekeeper/Scoreboard**

CEDAR STONE PARK: The League will not provide the scorekeeper and scorebook keeper. Each home team is responsible for keeping the book and each away team is responsible for doing the scoreboard.

TODD LANE: The League will provide both the scorekeeper and scorebook keeper.

- **Trophies**

- **Spirit Orders**

Spirit orders are offered online provided by VIP Awards. Please inform parents about the online spirit store. - **Uniforms**

-For 3/4, 5U, 6U, 7U, and 8U divisions, the uniform consists of a jersey, pants, hat, and belt. For the divisions 9U and 10U and up the uniform consists of a jersey, hat, and belt. The ordering has been done, and the uniforms are being printed now so there will not be an opportunity to change any sizes at this point. Shirts will be numbered one through eleven. The league provides last names on all jerseys for divisions 3/4 through 11/12.

-Uniform pick-up which will be **Thursday, August 28th, 5:30pm to 7:00pm @TBD**

- As in the past, you will be required to verify that uniforms are correct before you leave. Only one representative per team is required to pick up uniforms for your whole team. Not each individual parent. We should have an updated list for you, but it wouldn't hurt to ask your coach for a copy of their draft list that has uniform sizes on it and bring it with you! You must sign off that your uniforms were picked up and verified before you leave. Allow yourself the time to check and verify that everything is correct. If something is incorrect, this will be the **ONLY time** to notify myself, Rachel Harris, to try to get it corrected. If you leave without signing out, we will not be able to fix anything. Please Remember that in some cases we may have had to bump up sizes of players if the size they ordered was unavailable due to supply chain issues.

-Each team is only provided with 4 coaches shirts. Coaches' shirt sizes must be turned in by August 12th.

- **Team Drinks**

After each regular season game, each player/coach can go to the concession stand to receive their "team drink". Please note that "team drink" excludes Powerade or bottled water. **NO SUICIDES**. Please communicate to your parents these are for the players and **ONLY AFTER** they have completed their game. We also ask for Coaches to come up and get their own drink. We have a lot of players ask for both coach and player drink.

## **POLICY OVERVIEW**

Smyrna Baseball League (SBL) is committed to making baseball affordable and family-oriented, fostering a strong community. To support this goal, all participants (except those in the 3/4 division or those who opt for a buyout) are required to volunteer for concession duty.

## **BUYOUT OPTION**

Individuals who choose to buy out of concession duty will not be required to volunteer in the concession stand. The buyout fee, determined by SBL prior to each season, applies per child. Families with multiple children can select the buyout option for any or all their children. Concession buyout payments can be made during player registration or via the concession buyout link on our homepage.

## **CONCESSION VOLUNTEERS**

- The concession and game schedules will be posted at the start of the season, allowing volunteers to avoid working during their child's games.
- Volunteers will sign up for 4-hour shifts via a scheduling app at the start of the season. Every shift will include a concessions manager, worker, or board member to train and support volunteers. Shift length will be determined by the number of required shifts.

- Volunteers are not expected to operate the grill or fryer; each shift will have a paid cook.
- Individuals who do not sign up for a shift will be assigned to one and must fulfill it. Shifts will be assigned under the player's name.
- *If a volunteer misses their assigned shift, they will be required to pay the buyout fee, and the associated player will be ineligible to play until the fee is paid.*
- Volunteers are responsible for keeping track of their scheduled shifts.

### **MAKEUP GAMES**

When games are rescheduled due to the weather, the concession volunteer shifts may also be rescheduled. The SBL Board will decide on a case-by-case basis if the concession stand will open for rescheduled games and will notify volunteers with as much notice as possible.
