The 2020-2021 season is underway! How is it going? We are excited to be back for the season and we are looking forward to a continued safe and healthy year. In order to stay open, we need to ensure that all COVID screenings are completed on a daily basis when players are at the rink. Shakopee Hockey is committed to providing a safe environment for all of our players, coaches and volunteers. In order to continue staying open for the season please ensure that you are following the MN Hockey and D6 rules. ***If these are not followed, our season will be compromised:***

1. **Masks:** Please remember everyone in the Shakopee Ice Arena **MUST wear a mask at all times**. The only exceptions to this are players with their gear and helmet on and on-ice officials
2. **Spectators:** For all games and scrimmages, please respect the arena spectator policy. Each skater is allowed 2 spectators. Families doing game duties (scoresheet/ clock) are allowed 2 spectators in the stands. For all others who wish to watch, please direct them to www.livebarn.com (save 10% with this code: 437d-dd38). Both rinks have live feed
3. **RULE UPDATE:** 1 parent per player (players of all ages) will be permitted to watch practice. For players over the age of 10, the parent is permitted in the building 5 minutes before the start of practice. Parents observing practice must adhere to the social distance and masks policy of the [Shakopee Ice Arena](#).
4. **Score/ Penalty Box:** Max of 2 adults (from the same household) will be permitted in the box. Those adults are responsible for the clock, scoresheet and any assistance needed with the penalty box
