

CHEERLEADING FAQs

Can I change my child's sizes for camp/practice wear if I register before the fitting?

Yes. The sizes can be changed for you by the Cheer Director until May 25, 2024. No changes after this date..

What if my child just had a physical in December 2023- will I still need to complete a new physical?

Yes. The GFL requires each player to have a physical using the 2024 Physical Form and requires that the date of the physical be January 1, 2024 or later. No exceptions.

What happens if we cannot attend the mandatory fitting on 4/21/2024?

You will need to contact the Cheer Director for sizing guidelines.

When is cheer camp and where is it held?

Cheer camp for the 2024 season will be held July 29-August 1 at Parkview High School.

Why are shoes not listed as part of the uniform?

You may also choose to purchase an all-white cheer shoe from a store of your choice as long as it is a cheerleading shoe.

What is included in the cheer off fee?

Raffle tickets, GFL cheer off entry fee, and link to team video are included. The 2024 Kim Massengill Cheer Off tee is an optional item (\$15).

Why do I have to bring a certified birth certificate and a copy?

If your child is a new player we must validate each player's age with an official birth certificate to be uploaded into National Sports ID. The annual cost is \$10.

When are practices?

Practices start after cheer camp.

Practices are 2-3 days a week. Each team will decide the schedule that works best for them.

Practices are 1.5-2 hours long depending on the age of your cheerleader.

When are games?

Games are always held on Saturdays. It is a nine-week regular season & teams usually receive eight games during that time.

Playoffs are an additional four weeks and winners advance week to week.

Times & locations will be posted on the schedule.

The schedule will be sent from the GFL about a week prior to the first week's game.

Games start around the second week of August.

How long is the season?

The season runs from the end of July through the middle of October for the regular season.

Playoffs start in the middle of October & can go until the middle of November.

Where are games and practices held?

Practices are held at Mountain Park

Games are held at various parks in Gwinnett county. The Gwinnett Football League will give us a schedule with the parks where the games are held.

Are there admission fees to the games?

Yes – The GFL requires admission for all students & adults. Senior citizens & children below school age are free.

When will I hear from my coach?

Coaches will email or call once they are selected & the teams are set.

What is the inclement weather policy?

Football plays in the rain. When lighting is detected in the area of the park during practices, the director will make a decision to cancel practice or take cover & wait it out. If it's during a game, the GFL will make the call. Most likely, the game will be delayed & still played.

Can I get a refund once I have registered?

No. The refund policy for the MPAA is that there are no registration refunds allowed in any sport or activity.
