 - We have a lot of girls who really love cheer but can't commit to competition if we can get gym space. We were thinking of doing a skills clinic once or twice a month. We were thinking of January-June.

Football Commissioner:

- Requesting an executive board session at conclusion
- Overall I think that things went really well this season
- I started looking at other suppliers for jerseys
 - The supplier I was looking into sent artwork, it was not good, I sent a reply that we need
 - Trying to get preliminary examples from different suppliers
- Modified League- If we were to go this route I would like it to be 6th & 7th graders
 - Modified would be 9 on 9
 - We would not be able to do this model with our current field setup
 - It would be a 60 or 80 yard field,
 - We would need more refs would do shoulder pads, probably at least girdles, if not pants
 - This would be another game session which would extend the game
 - M. Mady- we need to recognize that this would eat into the senior level participation
 - J. Jayne- this would be in place of senior division
 - A. Neider- how would this affect cheer
 - If this division does not get cheerleaders then so be it
 - We would need 15 per team
 - For four teams we would need 60 kids 5th-8th grade
 - This would add in weight limits and weight minimums again
 - Coaches would have to take contact training
 - We will vote on this in January
