Policy: Standard First Aid



The Workplace Safety & Insurance Board (WSIB) recognizes the Lifesaving Society's Standard and Emergency First Aid programs. The Lifesaving Society first aid program is used to train aquatic candidates as well as non-aquatic staff for camps, playgrounds, maintenance, etc., as well as the general public.

Standard First Aid provides comprehensive training covering all aspects of first aid and CPR. Standard First Aid incorporates all of Emergency First Aid and is designed for those who require a more in-depth understanding of first aid including: legal implications of first aid treatment, spinal injuries, heat or cold injuries, bone and joint injuries, chest injuries, and medical emergencies. Includes CPR-C certification.

The Bradford Soccer Club offers training in Standard First Aid and CPR to volunteers within the clubs (including youth), as well our coaches, managers and match officials. We would be offering it three times a year and recommend that there is one person per team who is qualified. Once in the spring, fall and winter. The next date would be May 26, 2018. We can offer this at a reduced rate as one of our volunteer coaches is certified as a Standard First Aid Instructor and Examiner through the lifesaving society.
