

Pony Pride Training Fall Procedures

- Locker rooms will **NOT** be available for gearing up/down prior to or following ice times and hockey/equipment bags are **NOT** allowed in the facilities. Lobby areas have been set up with socially distanced chairs/seating for changing into/out of skates and putting on/removing helmets, other than that, players should arrive and leave in full gear. *Parking lot changing should be kept to a minimum!*

Due to goalie equipment needs, goalies are able to bring equipment bags into skate changing areas to gear up/down in the facility.

- Players should arrive no more than 15 minutes prior to their ice times. Players should be picked up within 10 minutes of their ice time ending. Loitering in/around facilities is not allowed.
- Facilities prefer that parents/guardians/spectators refrain from attending practices at this time. Should parents/guardians/spectators choose to stay, they should follow all social distancing practices in place; including following proper travel paths in the facility, sitting/standing in designated areas, and maintaining a social distance of at least 6ft from other parents/guardians/spectators at all times.
- Face masks/Personal Protective Equipment are required to enter the facilities. Face masks/PPE are *not* required while participating in on-ice activities. Players can remove face masks/PPE when they put their helmet on prior to taking the ice. Players should put face masks/PPE back on as soon as their helmet comes off following their ice time. Parents/guardians/spectators are required to wear face masks/PPE at all times when in the facilities. *PPT suggests players bring a ziplock or plastic baggie for face mask storage during practices.*
- Digital temperature scans will be taken upon entry into facilities. Entry into the facility will not be allowed should a patron's temperature be 100.4° or greater. *To keep the temperature scanning process moving, please remove hats/caps/helmets prior to entering the facility.*
- Restrooms will be available and disinfected frequently, but it is preferred that patrons "go" before arriving to the facility to keep restroom usage to a minimum.
- All patrons should follow facility signage and staff direction at all times.
- All common areas (lobbies, bleachers, bathrooms, etc) will be disinfected frequently throughout the day. Skate changing areas will be disinfected following each ice time.
- Water bottles should be clearly labeled with player's **first and last name** easily visible. Sharing of water bottles will not be allowed.
- Players who have not submitted a COVID-19/Illness Waiver this off-season will be required to do so prior to participating in the program. Waivers can be submitted at player check-in.
