- 6.) Scoreboard Update Matt Mohs
 - a. Dan Schraeder stated there are a number of businesses that have shown interest. There is 1 spot left on soccer, 3 spots on Baseball, 3 spots on softball, 2 spots left on football.
 - b. Tim had conversation with Lauren from Scheels about sponsoring. Possibly interested in being on all 4 scoreboards.
 - i. She had questions about the video board and number of attendees at events. How often will their name come up on the video board?
 - c. Ron is going to contact Fareway again as he has not heard back.
 - d. Possibility of Halcon wanting to be on Baseball and Softball
 - e. Tim mentioned that as long as we are generating interest we will not put a drop dead date on go or no go. Tim would like to continue the conversations and possibly branch to businesses outside of Stewartville. The group agreed.

- 7.) Concession Stand Discussion Ron Smith & Matt Mohs
 - a. Concession Stand Inspection review (failed for hot foods & drinks) Tim Malone
 - i. Inspector Findings:
 - Not happy with the hand washing station being outside the concession stand.
 Tim has called the custodians to get rid of the exterior hand washing station since it won't work anyway. Could possibly overcome this with a big Gatorade

- 2. Hot dogs and brats cannot be stored in the residential refrigerator, MUST be in an industrial refrigerator. Meat could be stored in the school but that wouldn't work for those who do not have keys to the school.
- 3. None of the utensils can be washed in the stand or taken home to wash. MUST be washed in an industrial type sink.
- ii. Could we use the pop cooler to store hotdogs/brats and keep overflow of pop in the refrigerator? Tim will call the Olmsted County inspector on 5/3 to determine if the pop refrigerator is considered industrial.
- iii. Could use throw away utensils or have multiple utensils?

 - i. Sam Stier discuss food trailer regulations
 - 1. Has a handwashing station but does not have a cooler
 - 2. Could we rent the trailer when the DU is not using it? Sam said that would be fine. We may need to do this if we do not get the new trailer in time.
 - 3. Trailer is 16X8 with 100 gallon water tank. Could take the utensils back to restaurant to clean.
 - 2 5/8 ball hitch, Inspection done at beginning of year and can go anywhere in Olmsted county, but for each event you go to they inspect again.

 - Bret Walters found a used 2015 trailer. Commercial, stainless, smoker/fryer/microwave, however Bret is going to stop and talk to the guy as he may be willing to sell for \$5,000.00.
