FORMAT AND NOTES FOR PROVINCIAL TOURNAMENTS

- For Provincial Championships at the “AAA” level – and at the “AA” and “A” level when four or fewer teams are registered – and all Eliminations, the tournament will be played over one weekend (it could be over two, three, four or five days, depending on the number of teams registered in the tournament).
- For all Provincial Championships at the “AA” and “A” levels with five or more teams registered, the round-robin will be played over one weekend, and the semi-finals and Final will be played on the following weekend (with generally the two semi-finals played on Day #1, and the Final played on Day #2).
- The draws and schedules found in this appendix is subject to change by the Board of Directors of Baseball PEI.

DRAWS

Two-Team Draw

- In a playoff series involving two (2) teams, the format shall be the best-of-three series with Games #1 and #2 played on Day #1 in one location, and Game #3 played on Day #2 in the other location. There will be a coin flip to determine who has home games the Tuesday before the series, with the team that has farther to travel to Charlottetown calling the coin flip. Whatever team wins the coin flip has the choice of two home games on Day #1 and one away game on Day #2, or two away games on Day #1 and one home game on Day #2.
- Two-team best-of-three series schedule (the times are suggested; they are subject to change by Baseball PEI due to various reasons. One field is necessary for this format):
 - Day #1
Game # 1: 11 am
Game # 2: 2 pm
 - Day #2
Game # 3 (if necessary): 11 am

Three-Team Draw

- All three-team draws shall be a double round-robin format played over one weekend. “A” will be the host team, “B” will be the second-closest team in terms of the location of the primary field, and “C” will be the team that must travel the farthest to get to the primary field.
- If one team is undefeated during the round robin it shall be declared the champion. Otherwise, the first and second place teams will play a single Championship game. Should all three teams finish the round robin with 2-2 records, the tie-breaking formula shall be used to determine first, second, and third place. In that scenario, first-place will advance to the Championship game, while second and third place plays a tie-breaker game. The winner of that tie-breaker game will advance to play the first-place team in a single Championship Game.
- The home team denoted in the round-robin will have the home game. There will be a coin flip for the Championship game
- Three-team round-robin single-weekend draw (the times are suggested; they are subject to change by Baseball PEI due to various reasons. One field is necessary for this format):

Four-Team Draw – Single-Weekend

- All four-team draws shall be a single round-robin format played over one weekend. “A” will be the host team, “B” will be the second-closest team (in terms of the location of the primary field), “C” will be the third-closest team and “D” will be the team that must travel the farthest to get to the primary field. A coin flip prior to each round-robin game will determine the home team for that game.
 - For any four-team draw determining two teams attending a Baseball Atlantic or Baseball Canada Championship, upon completion of the round-robin, teams finishing second and third place will play in a semi-final on Sunday morning, with the winner of that game advancing to the final to play the team finishing in first-place.
 - For any four-team draw determining one team attending a Baseball Atlantic or Baseball Canada Championship, upon completion of a round-robin, the first and second place teams shall advance to the Championship game. However, if the first-place team goes undefeated in the round-robin and other teams have 1-2 records, the first-place team shall be declared the champion and no Championship game will be required.
 - If three teams are tied at 2-1 after the round robin, the first-place team shall be determined using the tie-breaking procedure. The second- and third-place teams shall play a tie-breaking game with the winner advancing to play a single Championship game against the first-place team.
 - The higher-placing team under the tie-breaking procedure shall be the home team in each tie-breaking or first Championship game. If a second Championship game is required, a coin flip will determine the home team.
- A coin flip will be used to determine the home team for all round-robin games and if there is a second Championship game. The higher-ranked team will have a choice of a home game in the (first) Championship game.
- Four-team round-robin single-weekend draw (the times are suggested; they are subject to change by Baseball PEI due to various reasons. One field is necessary for this format):

Five-Team Draw – Single-Weekend

- All five-team single-weekend draws shall be a single round-robin format played over one weekend. “A” will be the host team, “B” will be second-closest team (in terms of the location of the primary field), “C” will be the third-closest team, “D” will be the fourth-closest team, and “E” will be the team that must travel the farthest to get to the primary field.
 - Upon completion of the round-robin, the first and second place teams shall advance to the championship game. However, if the first-place team goes undefeated in the round-robin and all other teams have at least two losses, the first-place team shall be declared champion and no championship game will be required.
 - At the 13U “AAA” level, where two representatives of PEI go to the Baseball Canada National Atlantic 13U Championships, if a team goes undefeated, it will be PEI #1. If three teams have a 2-2 record, the tie-breaking procedure will be used to determine second and third place. They will play a one-game playoff – to be played at the time the Championship game is scheduled – to determine who will represent PEI as PEI #2.
 - If the first-place team has a record of 4-0 and the second-place team has a record of 3-1, the second-place team must defeat the first-place team twice in order to win the championship (remember – no team can be eliminated unless they have two losses under this format) and two games shall be played if necessary.
 - If three teams are tied with a record of 3-1, the tie-breaking procedure will be used to determine the first, second, and third place teams. The first-place team will go directly to the Championship game, while the second and third place teams will have to play a tie-breaking game with the winner advancing to the Championship game.
 - The higher placing team under the tie-breaking procedure shall be the home team in each tie-breaking or first Championship game. If a second Championship game is required, a coin flip will determine the home team.
- There will be no coin flip for any games except a second Championship game, if necessary. The home team denoted in the round-robin will have the home game. The higher-ranked team will have a choice of a home game in the (first) Championship game.

Five-Team Draw – Two-Weekend

- All five-team two-weekend draws shall be a round-robin format played over one weekend at one location, with any tiebreakers or finals being played on the next weekend (at either the same or a different location). “A” will be the host team, “B” will be second-closest team (in terms of the location of the primary field), “C” will be the third-closest team, “D” will be the fourth-closest team and “E” will be the team that must travel the farthest to get to the primary field.
 - Upon completion of the round-robin, the top four teams shall advance to the semi-finals.
- There will be no coin flip for any round-robin games. The home team denoted in the round-robin will have the home game. The higher-placing team under the tie-breaking procedure shall have the choice of being the home team in each semi-final game. There will be a coin flip to determine home team prior to the Final.

Six-Team Draw – Single-Weekend

- All six-team single-weekend draws shall be scheduled as a two-pool format. Each team will be seeded 1 through 6 geographically (#1 being the team with the most western home field and #6 being the team with the most eastern home field). Pool “A” shall consist of teams #1, #4 and #6 and Pool “B” shall consist of teams #2, #3 and #5. Each team will play a single round-robin within their pool. The top team from each pool will advance to the semi-final. Second-place in each pool will play the third-place team in the other pool in the quarter-finals, with the winners of the quarter-finals advancing to the semi-finals (with the top-ranked team – based on the tie-breaking priorities – playing the lowest-ranked remaining team, and the second-ranked team playing the second-lowest ranked team). The winners of the semi-final games will advance to the Final. If records are identical after completion of pool play, the tie-breaking procedure will be used to determine rank.
- The only game in which there will be a coin flip to determine who has a choice of home game is the Final. The home team denoted in the round-robin will have the home game, and all quarter- and semi-final games will feature the higher-ranked team having the choice to be the home team.

Six-Team Draw – Two-Weekend

- All six-team two-weekend draws shall feature the round-robin and quarter-final games played one weekend at one location, with the semi-finals and Final played the next weekend. Each team will be seeded 1 through 6 geographically (#1 being the team with the most western home field and #6 being the team with the most eastern home field). Pool “A” shall consist of teams #1, #4 and #6 and Pool “B” shall consist of teams #2, #3 and #5. Each team will play a single round-robin within their pool. The top team from each pool will advance to the semi-final. Second-place in each pool will play the third-place team in the other pool in the quarter-finals, with the winners of the quarter-finals advancing to the semi-finals (with the top-ranked team – based on the tie-breaking priorities – playing the lowest-ranked remaining team, and the second-ranked team playing the second-lowest ranked team). If records are identical after completion of pool play, the tie-breaking procedure will be used to determine rank.
- The home team denoted in the round-robin will have the home game, and all quarter-final games will feature the higher-ranked team having the choice to be the home team.

Seven-Team Draw – Single-Weekend

- All seven-team single-weekend draws shall be scheduled as a two-pool format, Pool “A” consisting of four teams while Pool “B” shall consist of three teams. Each team will be seeded 1 through 7 geographically (#1 being the team with the most western home field and #7 being the team with the most eastern home field). Pool “A” shall consist of teams #1, #3, #5 and #7 and Pool “B” shall consist of teams #2, #4 and #6. The four-team pool will feature a single-round robin, with the top two teams advancing to the semi-finals. The three-team pool will feature a single round-robin. After the single round-robin in the three-team pool, there are seeding games to determine the two teams advancing to the semi-finals from the three-team pool.
 - If the three teams in the three-team pool all finish the round-robin with a record of 1-1, the tie-breaking procedures will determine who is first-place. The second- and third-place teams in Game 8 will place a designation game, with the winner of that game advancing to play the first-place team in Game 10. The winner of Game 10 will advance to semi-finals as first-place out of the three-team pool, while the loser will advance to semi-finals as second-place out of the pool.
 - If the three teams in the three-team pool finish with records of 2-0, 1-1 and 0-2, the teams will be designated “Top” (2-0), “Middle” (1-1) and “Bottom” (0-2). “Top” will be guaranteed a spot in the semi-finals.



- In Game 8, “Top” will play “Bottom.” If “Top” wins, they will advance to the semi-finals as first-place from the three-team pool. “Bottom” will have to play “Middle” in Game 10, but “Middle” will advance to the semi-finals as second-place from the three-team pool.
 - In Game 8, “Top” will play “Bottom.” If “Bottom” wins, “Top” will still advance to the semi-finals as first-place from the three-team pool. In Game 10, “Bottom” will play “Middle.” The winner of Game 10 will advance as second-place from the three-team pool in the semi-finals.
- All round-robin games will have the home team determined by coin flip. All semi-final games and the designation games in the three-team pool will have the higher-ranked team having the choice of home game.

Seven-Team Draw – Two-Weekend

- All seven-team two-weekend draws shall be scheduled as a two-pool format, Pool “A” consisting of four teams while Pool “B” shall consist of three teams. Each team will be seeded 1 through 7 geographically (#1 being the team with the most western home field and #7 being the team with the most eastern home field). Pool “A” shall consist of teams #1, #3, #5 and #7 and Pool “B” shall consist of teams #2, #4 and



#6. The four-team pool will feature a single-round robin, with the top two teams advancing to the semi-finals next weekend. The three-team pool will feature a single round-robin. After the single round-robin in the three-team pool, there are seeding games to determine the two teams advancing to the semi-finals from the three-team pool the next weekend.

- If the three teams in the three-team pool all finish the round-robin with a record of 1-1, the tie-breaking procedures will determine who is first-place. The second- and third-place teams in Game 8 will place a designation game, with the winner of that game advancing to play the first-place team in Game 10. The winner of Game 10 will advance to semi-finals as first-place out of the three-team pool, while the loser will advance to semi-finals as second-place out of the pool.
- If the three teams in the three-team pool finish with records of 2-0, 1-1 and 0-2, the teams will be designated “Top” (2-0), “Middle” (1-1) and “Bottom” (0-2). “Top” will be guaranteed a spot in the semi-finals.
 - In Game 8, “Top” will play “Bottom.” If “Top” wins, they will advance to the semi-finals as first-place from the three-team pool. “Bottom” will have to play “Middle” in Game 10, but “Middle” will advance to the semi-finals as second-place from the three-team pool.
 - In Game 8, “Top” will play “Bottom.” If “Bottom” wins, “Top” will still advance to the semi-finals as first-place from the three-team pool. In Game 10, “Bottom” will play “Middle.” The winner of Game 10 will advance as second-place from the three-team pool in the semi-finals.
- All round-robin games will have the home team determined by coin flip. All designation games in the three-team pool will have the higher-ranked team having the choice of home game.

- All eight-team single-weekend draws shall be scheduled as a two-pool format. Each team will be seeded 1 through 8 geographically (#1 being the team with the most western home field and #8 being the team with the most eastern home field). Pool “A” shall consist of teams #1, #3, #6 and #8 and Pool “B” shall consist of teams #2, #4, #5 and #7. Each team will play a single round-robin within their own pool. Upon completion of pool play, the top two teams from each pool will advance to the semi-finals with 2 “B” playing 1 “A” and 2 “A” playing 1 “B”, with the two winners advancing to the Championship game.
- A coin flip will determine home team in all round-robin games and in the Championship Game. Higher-seeded team in the semi-finals will have the choice of being the home team.

Eight-Team Draw – Two-Weekend

- All eight-team two-weekend draws shall feature the round-robin and quarter-final games played one weekend at one location, with the semi-finals and Final played the next weekend. Each team will be seeded 1 through 8 geographically (#1 being the team with the most western home field and #8 being the team with the most eastern home field). Pool “A” shall consist of teams #1, #3, #6 and #8 and Pool “B” shall consist of teams #2, #4, #5 and #7. Each team will play a single round-robin within their pool. Upon completion of pool play, the top two teams from each pool will advance to the Provincial semi-finals the following weekend with 2 “B” playing 1 “A” and 2 “A” playing 1 “B”, with the two winners advancing to the Championship game.
- A coin flip will determine home team in all round-robin games.

Nine-Team Draw – Single-Weekend

- All nine-team single-weekend draws shall consist of three pools of three teams. Each team will be seeded 1 through 9 geographically (#1 being the team with the most western home field and #9 being the team with the most eastern home field). Pool “A” shall consist of teams #1, #6 and #8; Pool “B” shall consist of teams #2, #4 and #9; and Pool “C” shall consist of teams #3, #5 and #7. Each team will play a single round-robin within their pool. After the round-robin, teams will be ranked one through nine based on their record and the tie-breaking procedures, with teams finishing first- through seventh-place will automatically advance to the quarter-finals. Teams finishing eighth- and ninth-place will play a playoff game, with the winner advancing to the quarter-finals. After the quarter-finals, winners will advance to the semi-finals, with the winners of the semi-finals advancing to the Final.
- The home team denoted in the round-robin will have the home game, and all quarter- and semi-final games will feature the higher-ranked team having the choice to be the home team. There will be a coin flip prior to the Final.

All Draws from Thirteen-Teams through Twenty-Teams

- For all draws for thirteen-teams through twenty-teams (or more if more teams than twenty are registered), there will be two regional tournaments with the top two teams from each regional tournament advancing to the semi-finals of the Provincial tournament.
 - Thirteen-team draw: one six-team regional draw and one seven-team regional draw.
 - Fourteen-team draw: two seven-team draws.
 - Fifteen-team draw: one seven-team draw and one eight-team draw.
 - Sixteen-team draw: two eight-team draws.
 - Seventeen-team draw: one eight-team draw and one nine-team draw.
 - Eighteen-team draw: two nine-team draws.
 - Nineteen-team draw: one nine-team draw and one ten-team draw.
 - Twenty-team draw: two ten-team draws.
- For odd-numbered draws, the regional draw with the odd-numbered draw will be determined by Baseball PEI (based on geographical proximity and other factors).
- For all thirteen- through twenty-team single-weekend draws (in the case usually for an Eliminations), Baseball PEI will determine the location and schedule for the semi-finals and Final of the overall Provincial tournament. It may vary slightly from the draws described.
