



# Divisional Formats

## March 13-15, 20-22 & 27-29 Weekends

**4 Teams:** Round Robin within division. At the end of the (3) game Round Robin the top 2 teams will play in the Championship Game. The bottom 2 teams will play a Consolation game.

**6 Teams:** 1 Pool 6 teams. Teams will play 3 preliminary games. After those games are completed, the top (2) Point-Earners in the pool will play the Championship Game. And the middle (2) and bottom (2) Point-Earners will play Consolation Games

**8 Teams:** 2 Pools of 4 teams each. Teams will play a Round Robin within their Pool. The top 2 Point-Earners in each Pool will play the Championship Game. The bottom 3 Point-Earners in each Pool will cross-over to play a Consolation Game.

In the event there is a tie for divisional winner, the Tournament Tie-Breaker system will be employed.

**NOTE: We will be playing the National Anthem prior to all Championship games.**
