2. Club Finances (Beth/Dawn): Beth reviews the financials; over \$9,000 deficit; we had expected some deficit. One question is regarding testing results; are these fully paid?; we have only 3 sponsorships so far. Confirmed that salary for LTS director will be \$600 per month.
