THE WEEK IN REVIEW

AMW AND SHOWTIME ENTERED THE WEEK WITH IDENTICAL 6-8 MARKS AS WELL AS SPLITTING THE 4 GAMES THAT THEY HAVE PLAYED THIS YEAR. THIS FINAL WEEK WOULD DETERMINE WHICH TEAM WILL MAKE IT. THE BOTTOM LINE, JUST DO IT NEEDED A SWEEP OVER AMW TO STAY ALIVE, AND SHOWTIME HAD TO AT LEAST KEEP PACE WITH AMW TO FORCE A TIE BREAKER.

SHOWTIME WAS MATCHED UP AGAINST DREAM TEAM IN THE EARLY GAME WHILE AMW/JUST DO IT WAS SCHEDULED DIRECTLY TO FOLLOW. SHOMER OFFERED HOSS A BRIBE IF HE WAS WILLING TO THROW THE GAME. HOSS' ANSWER, "I'D LOVE TO THROW THE GAME, BUT I DON'T PLAY!" SHOMER THEN TRIED TO CONVINCING MICHEAL SALOMON. HIS REPLY, "APOLOGIZE TO MY BROTHER ADAM, AND YOU GOT A DEAL. SHOMER SAYS "PASS, WILL WIN IT ON OUR OWN." JOE TOBIAS WALKED 2 BATTERS IN THE FIRST, AND AVI ESSES KNOCKED IN THE GAME'S 1ST RUN. THE MAGNITUDE OF THE GAME WAS FELT BY SHOWTIME WHO WERE UNABLE TO COME THROUGH IN THE BIG GAME. THEY MANAGED ONLY 1 HIT THROUGH 4 INNINGS AND ONLY 4 FOUR THE GAME. ISAAC SAKA ADDED A HR AND A 3B FOR 4 RBI AND SHOWTIME LOST THE GAME 5-0.

IT WAS OBVIOUSLY A MUST GAME FOR SHOWTIME BECAUSE IF THEY WOULD LOSE THIS ONE THEIR SEASON WAS BASICALLY OVER. SHOMER SAYS "THIS IS THE LAST DAHILAK SPEECH I'M GONNA GIVE BUT DAHILAK WE NEED THIS GAME!" THE GAME WAS A PITCHERS DUEL AS IT WAS 0-0 THROUGH 4 INNINGS. THAT MEANS THAT SHOWTIME HAD NOT SCORED IN 11 INNINGS IN THE WEEK THAT DETERMINED THEIR SEASON. FINALLY WITH 2 OUTS BENNY'S SINGLE WAS FOLLOWED BY AN ISAAC DWECK DOUBLE. RAYMOND COHEN WAS ABLE TO COME THROUGH WITH A HUGE SINGLE TO PUT SHOWTIME ON TOP 2-0. SHOWTIME REALIZED THAT DEFENSE WAS THE KEY. BUT WITH TWO OUTS, A DROPPED BALL AND A MISJUDGED FLY BALL THAT RESULTED IN A 2 RUN TYING HOME RUN, IT WAS A BRAND NEW GAME. THE TOP OF THE ORDER FOR SHOWTIME RESPONDED AS SOLLY, SHOMER, AND JT REACH BASE AND HADDAD KNOCKS 2 RUNS IN ON A LONG SAC FLY. THE GAME WAS INTENSE, AS TEMPERED FLARED IN THE 7TH WHEN SHOMER GOT INVOLVED IN A BENCH CLEARING BRAWL WITH SUPRISE...SUPRISE...ZACK GINDI! THE RESULT, SHOWTIME WAS ABLE TO HOLD ON AND HOPE FOR A SPLIT BY AMW/JDI TO INSURE A PLAY-OFF GAME.

THE BIG GAME !

ALTHOUGH THE SHOWTIME WIN ENDED ALL HOPE FOR JDI, THE TWO TEAMS BATTLED IN WHAT TURNED OUT TO BE ONE OF THE MOST CLASSIC DOUBLE-HEADERS. THERE WAS MORE ACTION OFF THE FIELD THAN ON THE FIELD. CHUBBY DECLARED THAT JUST DO IT WAS PLAYING FOR PRIDE, AND THEY WOULD NOT LAY DOWN AND DIE, AND HE EVEN WENT OUT ON A LIMB AND PREDICTED A SWEEP. HE WAS RIGHT. THERE WAS A SWEEP. JDI CAME OUT PUMPED AS THEY SCORE 3 IN THE 1ST TO PUT THE PRESSURE ON MORABIA AND CO. (INCIDENTLY, MORABIA LOST A PLAY-OFF SPOT LAST YEAR ON THE LAST GAME OF THE YEAR.) SHOMER WAS ON THE SIDELINES BARKING, "WOOF WOOF" AS THE GAME MOVED ALONG. AMW WAS ABLE TO CUT IT TO 3-1 AS THE GAME MOVED TO THE BOTTOM OF THE 4TH. THAT'S WHEN ALL HELL BROKE LOOSE. JACK FARCA WAS EJECTED FROM THE GAME FOR A 'DISRUPTION'. THE GAME WAS DELAYED BUT WHEN ACTION FINALLY CONTINUED, A NEW AMW CAME TO PLAY. 4 CONSECUTIVE HITS, AND

MORRIS SHAMAH'S AMAZING SPEED AND HEADS UP PLAY, AS HE WAS ABLE TO TAG UP FROM 3RD ON AN INFIELD POP UP, GAVE AMW A 4-3 LEAD. TRAILING 5-3, CHUBBY DECIDED TO TAKE MATTERS IN HIS OWN HANDS. HE WAS CREDITED WITH A HOME RUN. IT WAS A HR THAT TOOK 4 MINUTES TO COMPLETE. LAUGHTER ERUPTED AS FANS WITNESSED CHUBBY'S FIRST HOMER SINCE 1947! HOWEVER IT WAS NOT ENOUGH AS AMW WAS ABLE TO WIN THE GAME, CLINCHING AT LEAST A ONE GAME PLAY-OFF.

THIS MEANT THAT SHOWTIME WOULD BE ELIMINATED IF AMW COULD WIN THE SECOND GAME. "DAHILAK, DO IT FOR ME GUYS, DON'T YOU WANT TO SEE ME IN THE PLAYOFFS?," SAID A WORRIED SHOMER. DASH WAS MOVED, AS HE KNOCKED IN HIS 1ST RUN OF THE MONTH, AS JDI JUMPED OUT TO A QUICK 2-0 LEAD. AMW GOT IT THE RUNS BACK TO TIE IT AT 2-AT THE END OF 1. JDI PULLS AWAY AS BIG DOG HITS A MAMMOTH HR TO SHORT CENTER, FOLLOWED BY A RBI TRIPLE BY STASH, WHO WAS THROWN OUT AT THE PLATE. (KEEP THAT IN MIND). LEADING 5-2, JDI THREATENED AS THEY LOADED THE BASES WITH 0 OUTS, BUT WERE UNABLE TO SCORE. (KEEP THAT IN MIND). JDI ADD 2 MORE RUNS TO MAKE IT 7-2 BOTTOM OF THE 6TH. AMW HAD A TOWN MEETING AND CAME UP WITH A PLAN, "HECKLE DASHEAR." THIS WAS A LAST DITCH EFFORT BY AMW WHO BASICALLY CONCEEDED DEFEAT. MO SHAMAH HOMERS TO CUT IT TO 7-3. AMW WOULD NOT DIE. WITH TWO OUTS, DASH ALLOWS SOLLY TO REACH BASE. (KEEP THAT IN MIND). AMW RALLY AS BEDA SINGLES, AND MORABIA HITS A SCREAMING LINER TO LEFT (HE'S A LEFTY) THAT BARLEY NIPPED THE CHALK FOR A 2 RUN TRIPLE. IT WAS HIS 1ST OPPOSITE FIELD HIT IN THREE YEARS! THE SCORE WAS NOW 7-6.

BOTTOM 7. LAST CHANCE Foe AMW. FREDDY B SINGLES. JASON HITS A BULLET THAT MFRANCO MIRACULOUSLY IS ABLE TO COME UP WITH AS THE 1ST OUT WAS MADE. JD SINGLED, BUT MO SHAMAH FLIED TO LEFT. 2 OUTS, 2 ON, FOR JASON COHEN, AMW DOWN BY 1. TYING RUN ON 2ND, WINNING RUN ON 1ST. SHOMER'S SHAKING, BUCA'S CURSING HIS BROTHER OUT. LOOSE IS PRAYING, HELENE WAS PSYCHED, ABIE SAKA WAS COUNTING HIS MONEY. THE COUNT 0-1. JASON DRILLS A LINER TO RIGHT FIELD, RIGHT TO MOEY IN RF, HE GETS UNDER IT AND CATCHES IT...BUT WAIT, "I CAN'T LET SHOMER MAKE THE PLAY-OFFS!" 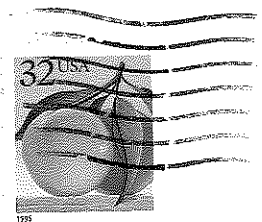
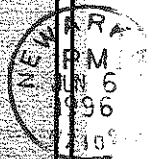
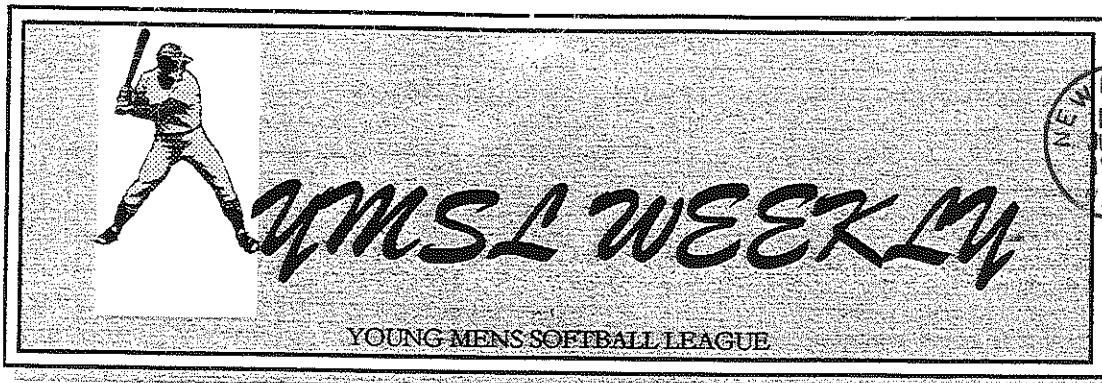
