

## TTA SIGNUP GUIDELINES

- Any town that is affiliated with Texas Teenage MUST have sign-ups with posted ending date for each age group available through Texas Teenage for either Boys or Girls that they are affiliating.
    - Sign-ups must be open to any and all kids who live in that school district boundary and/or attend that town affiliate local school.
  - If a child either attends school in the town affiliate and lives outside that town affiliate's school district boundary (or vice versa), that child MUST sign up in the same place they played at last season (unless they are changing age division).
  - If a child signed up legally last season and was required to play in a different area than where they attend school/town boundary line they live (not enough players, too many in an age group, etc.), the child must return to the same town affiliate they signed up for last season.
    - Child is not to sign up in the town they were required to play in last season.
      - Child must sign up in their town affiliate where they live or go to school.
    - Please note when signing up this season, information stating they were required to play in a different affiliate last season will be helpful.
  - If a child was illegally signed up in the wrong town affiliate last season, that child must return to their legal town affiliate and sign up this season.
    - The child will not be allowed to return to the illegal town affiliate this season.
    - The child will not have any ties to the illegal town this season.
  - We encourage TTA town boards to follow these guidelines/questions to help ensure that all players are legal to sign up in their affiliate town to ensure they have no illegal players.
    - Any questions or concerns, contact your local State director to help ensure all players are signed up legally.
  - Discussion for process for player placement pool will be discussed in a later document.

- ❖ **100% legal**
    - Child attends same public school as town affiliate **AND** child's physical address resides in town affiliate ISD boundary line.
  - ❖ **50% legal** (Must ask questions to ensure child is in correct town)
    - Child attends same public school as town affiliate, but child's physical address is NOT inside town affiliate ISD boundary line.
    - Child's physical address is inside town affiliate ISD boundary line, but child does NOT attend same public school as town affiliate.
  - ❖ **0% legal**
    - Child does not attend same public school as town affiliate AND child's physical address is not inside the town affiliate ISD boundary line.
    - **Please contact your local State Director for instructions.**
    - Do not add this registration form to your town sign-up numbers.

## **PART 1**

- **1<sup>st</sup> question to ask: Does the child attend the same public school as the town affiliate offering signups?**
  - **IF ANSWER IS “NO” – Skip to Part 2 of page**
  
  - IF ANSWER IS “YES” (child attends same public school as the town affiliate)
    - **Ask next question:** Does the child’s physical address reside in the town affiliate ISD boundary line? (use TEA school district locator)
      - IF ANSWER IS “YES” (child attends the same public school as the town affiliate and child’s physical address is in town affiliate ISD boundary line).
        - 100% legal**
        - **Child is legal to sign up in that town.**
  
      - IF ANSWER IS “NO” (physical address is NOT in town affiliate ISD boundary line).
        - 50% legal**
        - **Ask next question:** Where did child play last season?
          - Answer: Child played in the same town affiliate.
            - Child is legal to sign up in that town.
  
          - Answer: Child played in another affiliate town last season and are still in the same age division.
            - Child is not legal to sign up in your town affiliate.
            - You need to inform that child/parent they must return to the town affiliate where they played last season and sign up.
              - TTA RULE: child must remain in that town for the remainder of that age division.
  
          - Answer: Child played in another affiliate town last season and has changed age divisions.
            - That child is legal to sign up in your affiliate town.
            - Inform parents they will need to sign up in your affiliate town next season.
              - TTA RULE: child must remain in that town for the remainder of that age division.
  
          - Answer: Child did not play last season
            - That child is legal to sign up in your affiliate town.
            - Inform parents they will need to sign up in your affiliate town next season.
              - TTA RULE: child must remain in that town for the remainder of that age division.

## **PART 2**

- If answered “NO” to first question in PART 1 to the original question listed above, (Does the child attend the same public school as the town affiliate offering signups):
  - Ask next question: Is the child’s physical address reside in the towns affiliate ISD boundary line? (use TEA school district locator)
    - IF ANSWER IS “YES” (child’s physical address is in the towns affiliate ISD boundary line).  
**50% legal**
    - Ask next question: Where did child play last season?
      - **Answer:** Child played in the same town affiliate.
        - Child is legal to sign up in that town.
      - **Answer:** Child played in another affiliate town last season and are still in the same age division.
        - Child is not legal to sign up in your town affiliate.
        - You need to inform that child/parent they must return to the town affiliate where they played last season and sign up.
      - **Answer:** Child played in another affiliate town last season and has changed age divisions.
        - That child is legal to sign up in your affiliate town.
        - Inform parents they will need to sign up in your affiliate town next season.
          - TTA RULE: child must remain in that town for the remainder of that age division.
      - **Answer:** Child did not play last season.
        - That child is legal to sign up in your affiliate town. Inform parents they will need to sign up in your affiliate town next season.
          - TTA RULE: child must remain in that town for the remainder of that age division.

## ➤ **PART 3**

- If answered “NO” to PART 1 AND PART 2 of the questions listed above about child’s school attended and child’s physical address:
  - Child is not a legal sign up and not allowed to count towards your town’s numbers for signups. **0% legal**
    - RULE: Town president will take the child’s registration form out of the town’s official numbers.
    - Contact their State Director for guidance regarding where this child will need to be placed for signups.
      - The area State Director will run milage from the child’s physical address to the nearest TTA ISD boundary line.
      - Affiliate player placement committee will begin when affiliate signups are completed.
