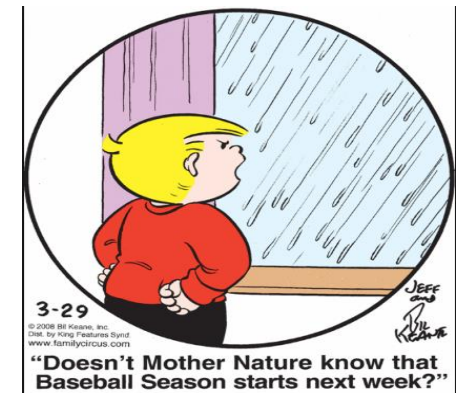


What is a hit?

When a batter hits the ball and reaches base safely, how do you know if it should be scored as a hit or not? Generally, it is scored a hit unless he reached via an error or a fielder's choice. Essentially a hit is given except when any of the following apply:

- An **error** was charged to a fielder, and the batter would have been put out if not for the error.
- A runner is forced out.
- An infielder puts out a runner trying to advance one base.
- A fielder tries unsuccessfully to put out a runner trying to advance one base, but would have had the batter out.
- Also, no hit is given if a runner is called out for interfering with a fielder attempting to field a ball.
- Also note that if a batter is called out on appeal for having missed first base, he does not get credit for a hit.
 - So, your little slugger may hit a ball and reach home plate, but if he should have been out, it is not a home run.
