2. TAGA's Role:
 - a. 501c3 Non-profit volunteer parent organization started in 2013 by Christine .Idea behind is to enhance the experience of your kids - by taking kids to Gopher meet, \$30,000 of scholarship, pizza party, more that \$30,000 of equipment to MHS, helped families pay for fees as needed, helped with leos and grips. 1. Feedback and Questions

The School Board came to look at the gym and at the time agreed there was a need. It did not make it into the final referendum.  - b. There are three ideas that Kiki is still working on:
 - i. Still trying to see if we can have a building in that area. Kiki working with a contact (Ellen) to raise money for a building and help with gathering all parties involved (strength and wrestling) to test in the community for interest and support, and go to the school board. This is Kiki's first choice.
 - ii. Continue talking with Ted about digging a pit in the current space.
 - iii. Look for a building in the area or a piece of land. This would be Kiki's 2nd choice.
2. Fundraising:
 - a. Coffee is done. \$7/bag for buyout. Pay to TAGA.
 - b. Awards at the banquet for top sellers of coffee and poinsettia
3. Banquet is coming up. Still looking for volunteers for decoration/set up and seating chart. Let Molly know.
