#### Timeline:

**Eliminations will be made after each round as deemed appropriate.**

**Please note, there will be additional mandatory dates for team meetings if you make the team (no exceptions), but the dates are currently TBD.**

- **Requirements:**
- Must be 18 years of age by June 10, 2018 (no exceptions). There is no limit for maximum age.
- Must have a high school diploma or G.E.D.
- Must at least have a part-time job or be a part-time student or be a full-time mom.
- No height or weight requirements, but you must be in good physical condition.
  
- **Time Commitment:**
- Rehearsals are usually 9 hours each week. Typically Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, 6pm – 9pm (subject to change)
- During the season, the time commitment is around 16 hours per week, including games.
- Rangerettes are also required to do a minimum of 25 appearances each year
- Most of our team members are full-time students, full-time mothers, or have full-time jobs
- Being a Saddleback Valley Ranger Cheerleader is not a full-time job, although Cheerleaders have the opportunity to earn a stipend for taking a leadership role in the community and the Above the Line program.
  
- **Audition Attire:**
- Wear dance friendly shoes (tennis shoes recommended)
- Dance hot pants or briefs (NO THONGS)
- Midriff top
- Hair & makeup need to be performance quality (no ponytails). No unnatural hair colors such as blue, pink, purple, etc.
- Please no visible tattoos. Cover up with make-up if necessary.
- No loose jewelry

**What to Bring:**

- Current photo, 5X7 or larger (will not be returned)
- Audition Application with completed and signed waiver (also available at registration table)
- Valid photo ID
- Water, dry snacks, mirrors, blankets
- Prohibited items: messy food, bobby pins, safety pins, gum, sunflower seeds

**Is it free to try out?**

- No. There is a registration fee of **\$25.00** to try out

**Can my family come and watch auditions?**

**What will judges be looking for?**

- Appearance, Dance Ability, Showmanship, Poise, Personality, Attitude, Work Ethic, Education and Future Goals

**What can I do to prepare for auditions?**

- Dance! Call your local dance studio and ask about technique and choreography classes
- Work on stretching, kicks, turns, and choreography. You can even join a funk or hip-hop aerobics class
- You need to be able to pick up choreography fairly quickly and feel comfortable performing for the judges
- Work out!
