

Re-Opening Policies and Procedures

Idaho Soccer Center Patrons:

When you come to our facility, we want you to fully enjoy your time around the game of soccer, knowing that your safety is our highest priority. We initiated appropriate preventative measures to address Coronavirus (COVID-19), ensuring that our protocols meet or exceed the guidelines of Central District Health and Idaho Rebounds Stages and Protocols for Recreational Facilities. We will be staying current with this evolving situation with the goal of doing our part to help stave off the spread of COVID-19; while at the same time allowing our customers to live a normal life and our employees to maintain gainful employment.

We appreciate everyone's patience and flexibility as we cope with this unprecedented time. We have made some modifications to our building and facility rules. Please take the time to read them below.

Limiting exposure to COVID-19

- For our customers, please stay home if you are sick or have been around someone who is sick.
- **Due to Local Recommendations and Idaho Soccer Center Policy, FACE MASKS ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES in facility unless you are**
 - 1) a player on the field.
 - 2) a player in the player box.
 - 3) under the age of two.
- ***If you have a medical condition that precludes you from wearing a mask, Face Shields will be required and will be for sale in the pro-shop ***
- The main entryway will be used for ENTRY only. Side doors will be used for EXIT only.
- We will extend time in between games to clean high touch areas. For this reason, we ask you not to enter the facility until 5-10 minutes before your scheduled start time.

General Facility Rules:

- **LIMITED SPECTATORS FOR ADULT GAMES.**
- **YOUTH GAMES: RECOMMENDED 1 ADULT PER CHILD, NOT TO EXCEED 2 ADULTS PER CHILD—both of these are being strictly enforced by ISC Staff.**
- Everyone must maintain the social distance of 6 feet as much as possible while in the facility.
- **At end of game please leave facility as soon as possible through side doors closest to your bench.**
- Seating has been limited to help enforce social distancing guidelines.
- Please bring only one water bottle into the facility. Preferably labeled with your name.
- No coolers or outside foods.
- There will be no spitting in the game boxes/field/facility, if you spit you will be receiving a RED CARD.
- We will extend time in between games to clean high touch areas. For this reason, we ask you not to enter the facility until 5-10 minutes before your scheduled start time.

Idaho Soccer Center Staff:

- All staff will wear masks while in the facility.
- Sick employees will be sent home.
- All surfaces will be wiped down at regular intervals.
- Field will be sanitized daily.
- Pro-shop will be open. Please adhere to social distancing markers.

Adult Leagues:

- Players only in players box. **LIMITED SPECTATORS – Strictly Enforced**
- Recommended that all players sanitize hands before and after games.
- No outside chairs, equipment, etc.
- Refrain from high fives, handshakes, etc.
- **At end of game please leave facility as soon as possible through side doors closest to the bench area**
- When possible please pay for teams and player cards online to limit staff contact.
- Adult team referee fees will continue to be paid in cash.
- We will extend time in between games to clean high touch areas. For this reason, we ask you not to enter the facility until 5-10 minutes before your scheduled start time.

Youth Leagues:

- Players and coaches **ONLY** in players box.
- For youth league games it is a recommended limit of one adult per playing child – not to exceed two adults per child - **Strictly Enforced**
- All spectators must observe the social distance of 6 feet as much as possible while in the facility.
- Recommended that all players sanitize hands before and after games.
- No outside chairs, equipment, etc.
- Refrain from high fives, handshakes, etc.
- **At end of game please leave facility as soon as possible through side doors**
- We will extend time in between games to clean high touch areas. For this reason, we ask you not to enter the facility until 5-10 minutes before your scheduled start time.

This is a big change for everyone, so we ask you to be patient and flexible to help us keep our doors open and follow our new regulations. Thank you for your patience and understanding.
