Recommendations

Locker room policy

We are asking for up to 3 volunteers per level to open and monitor locker room before every practice. They will receive 18 credits for the season to split. They must be safe sport certified and have had a background check.

The coaches will be responsible to monitor after practice until the last player leaves.

For games: The coach will monitor both before and after the game. They should enter the locker room as a team before the game with the coach. In the case of Varsity/JV or similar circumstances a parent may monitor between games as the upper level gets ready and the lower level finishes.

Question for the city on if they are going to lock the locker rooms? If so we recommend that we have a common place for keys or add key box by every locker room.

Cell Phone policy

We recommend that a lockable box or safe suited for cell phones be placed in every locker room. For away game, the coach is to have a bag to collect cell phones.
