Saints of the Week

February 14th, Valentine's Day, is often thought to



be the feast day of St. Valentine. It is not well known that this day is actually the feast of two Greek brothers, **Sts. Cyril and Methodius**. These brothers resided in a part of Greece that was largely populated by Slavic people. They took it upon them as their mission to ensure the Slavic people

could worship in the language they understood, standing up to many in authority to translate the liturgy into the Slavic language. They were not named saints because they translated the liturgy, but because they did so with the courage and humility of Christ.
