



Netforce Tryouts Covid-19 Procedures

Before tryout day

1. Must have a current USA Volleyball Membership. **You will need this membership number to register.**
 - a. If you didn't play club volleyball last season you will need a Tryout Membership that will open September 1st at <http://www.greatlakesvolleyball.org/wix/index3.cfm?action=registration>
 - b. If you played club volleyball last season your membership is good until October 31st.
2. To Register for Tryouts, go to the Net Force website and click on Tryouts 2020-2021. This will take you to the registration link which is... <https://netforcevolleyball.sportngin.com/register/form/515945435>.
3. **Bring Water!** The Field House water stations are not in use.

Upon arrival of girls trying out

1. Temperatures will be taken upon arrival right before entry into the fieldhouse
 - a. Every person's temperature will be taken and put into an excel sheet and initialed by whoever took that temperature.
2. Every person must have a mask on and keep it on for the duration of the tryout.
3. Hand Sanitizer will be available in multiple areas.
4. Due to Field House regulations the maximum capacity on each court is limited to players and Net Force Staff only. **Parents will not be allowed to watch in the gym.**
5. Lastly before they are allowed into the building you will be asked the typical questions: Have you exhibited any symptoms or came into contact with someone who has shown symptoms or tested positive for Covid. **(If they answer yes, they must wait 10 days and not show any symptoms OR not have a fever and feeling better [without fever reducing medicine] OR prove they are negative with 2 negative Covid tests in a row at least 24 hours apart.)**

Once inside the building

1. PLAYERS ONLY will go to the front room to check in and grab their tryout shirt.
2. Player should change into the tryout shirt and go into the gym.

Inside gym

1. Players are to leave their bags 6ft apart from everyone else's bags (Per Illinois sports recommendations/guidelines)
2. Everyone must have a mask on during the entire event. Even players during the tryout. (Per Illinois sports recommendations/guidelines)
3. No hugging of friends, high-fiving, fist bumping, or contact "go team" etc. (Per Illinois sports recommendations/guidelines)
4. Hand sanitizer is available at each Court.
5. There must be at least 30 feet between the groups. No more than 50 people to a court/group. (This count is including Net Force Staff.)

For staff

1. We will be making sure to give lots of water breaks as the masks will make it very hot to play volleyball in.
2. Volleyballs will be sanitized between sessions.
